### Purpose of

The Purpose of this Report is to inform the Board of Trustees about the safety and drainage issues related to the track and field area at Ryan High School.

### Objectives

- Provide better drainage for the track and field area so heavy rains will not damage subsurface or surface areas in and around the track and field.
- Provide a new track surface for athletes to run on.
- Provide a new turf field for athletes to practice on and play competitive games on.

### Operational Impact

- Entire track and field area will be off limits to students & staff during the construction process.
- Complete construction process will take 8-12 weeks.
- Ryan High coaches would like to start the construction immediately after football is over.
- This process will not affect soccer since they have other practice fields and they cannot play any competitive games on the main field due to the safety issues we are addressing.
- The estimated cost for this work is \$1,578,640.00. The remaining funds available in the 2002 Bond Authorization is \$2,459,096.28.

### Results

The renovation of the track and field areas will provide safe areas for athletes to practice and play competitively on for many years. If this work is not completed athletes will continue to be limited to only practice at this facility and only in certain areas.
