

### MUSICAL THEATRE CURRICULUM PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS PERFORMANCE TRACK

### **Acting**

Acting classes provide an in-depth study of acting techniques including Alexander, Stanislavski, and Shakespeare. Students will learn the stage basics inherent in these techniques. They will learn a working theatre vocabulary and will gain skills in analysis, acting, creativity, self-expression, and improvisation.

### **Rehearsal & Performance**

Each semester students participate in rehearsal and performance to develop their acting techniques and theatre skills in a theatre company setting. Students will demonstrate an ability to apply the fundamentals and techniques of their craft to main stage productions and performances. Regular performances in a variety of settings is part of this study. Learning to participate and collaborate in a group is vitally important in this class.

### Diction

Designed to help students improve and practice the basic techniques of developing a clear and expressive speaking voice. Breath control, phonation, placement, projection, and articulation will be the focus to improve pitch and overall vocal quality.

### **Ballet**

Ballet classes are designed to explore the foundational elements and techniques of ballet and progress to advanced levels of classical ballet training.

### Tap

Tap classes begin with an introduction to the basic tap dance techniques and progress to advanced tap.

### **Modern Dance**

Modern Dance begins with foundational studies of human movement as an art form with focus on developing strength, flexibility, and coordination. A variety of modern and contemporary dance forms are explored.

### Jazz/Hip Hop

Jazz/hip hop classes begin with an introduction to American Jazz dance styles and techniques and advances to a variety of Jazz styles including contemporary, lyric, classical, and hip hop.

### **Applied Lesson**

All students enrolled in musical theatre take a weekly private, one-on-one lesson with an instructor. Lessons range from 30-60 minutes weekly and are designed to focus on developing proper technique in the student along with advanced training in musicianship and preparation for performances, productions, and on-stage experiences. Repertoire in a variety of styles will be explored initially with an emphasis on Broadway and musical theatre styles.

### Musical Theatre Workshop

An additional class to work in connection with the Rehearsal & Performance course in which students learn to work together, critique one another, practice auditioning, develop on-stage skills, and develop leadership roles in back-stage technical work. Performances are part of this class.

### Auditioning

Designed to help students learn how to select and prepare material for auditions. Students will prepare for college and professional auditions. They will also create a personal mission statement and five-year plan to use as a guide toward planning a career.

### Voice & Movement

A class designed to explore the student's range of vocal and physical techniques for creative expression in performance. Through exercises, training, and performances, students will have the opportunity to reduce habitual tensions, connect their movement and voice to imagery and text, and increase the strength, flexibility and dynamic of their bodies in performance. Students will gain skills to improve their physical awareness, body alignment, and movement and vocal range.

### **Script Analysis**

Designed to explore important tools and strategies for reading and analyzing scripts and dramatic literature. Through a variety of classical and contemporary readings, students will develop new critical thinking skills to further their growth as artists.

### Stage Combat

An introductory course to stage fighting techniques as well as safety methods. Students will explore both armed and unarmed combat to start developing fight choreography.

### Stage Makeup

An introductory course to practical makeup design principles and application techniques. Students will explore facial structure, aging, shadow, highlight, paint modeling, latex usage, wounds, and other basic techniques of theatrical makeup.

### **Devised Theatre**

The course is a culmination of acting classes in which students will collaborate to create an original work using a full range of acting and improvisation techniques to present as a public performance.

### **College Preparation**

Designed to help students put a career in the arts into perspective. Students will reflect on their high school arts studies, create a personal mission statement, research colleges with theatre programs, research professional theatre opportunities, and develop a five-year plan with future goals.

### **Musical Theatre Literature**

Designed to teach students the history of the elements and styles of musical theatre. A study of composers, lyricists, producers, directors, choreographers, performers, and conductors will be reviewed in context with the social-historical events and philosophies of the time.

### Musical Theatre Choreography

Designed to focus on elements of dancing, singing, and acting in relation to the on stage performance. Students will utilize skills learned in previous dance classes and rehearsal sessions.

### Directing

Designed to give students a new perspective and analytical mindset of the production process. Students will work through the directing process and the collaborative nature of this craft as they prepare to direct their peers in a showcase.

### **Senior Showcase**

Each senior will perform in recital style to showcase the work they have accomplished. Students will work with a music director, choreographer, and acting instructor to prepare this performance.

### **TECHNICAL THEATRE TRACK**

### **Script Analysis**

The study of dramatic structure and methods of analysis as a preparation for producing, performing, directing, designing, writing, and critiquing scripts. Students will study and dissect the plot, characters, language style, elements of the genre, and overall themes.

### **Introduction to Theatrical Design**

An introductory class to the world of stage and theatrical design. Elements of study include scenery, costuming, lighting, projections, and properties. Students will gain a basic understanding of the design process behind on stage performing.

### Stagecraft

This is a basic course in gaining knowledge of the tools and equipment used in theatre, construction of stage scenery and properties, and overall backstage procedures.

### Scenic Design

This course focuses on the principles and practices of designing scenery through the development of skills in script analysis, research, previsualization, sketching, model building, drafting, and rendering.

### Stagecraft Lab

Students will provide backstage assistance with sets, properties, and stage crews for live productions.

### **Stage Lighting**

A beginning course in stage lighting including the elements of electricity and circuitry, principles of lighting for productions, and hands-on training of mounting and setting lights.

### **Sound Design & Engineering**

The study of basic concepts and skills for designing sound for stage productions. Students will explore the aesthetic and practical use of sound effects, use of digital audio editing, and recording of sound for productions.

### **Stage Production & Management**

A course designed to give students the background and skills necessary to function as an effective organizational manager throughout an on-stage production. Topics include the production process, rehearsal and performance procedures, auditions, communication, and organization.

### **Costume Design**

Designed for students to gain a basic understanding of costume design and the construction process, operation of a costume shop, and the use of costumes as they relate to the performer's development of a character and the overall production.

### **Lighting Design**

Students will learn how to design lights for productions. Studies will include the elements of color theory, play analysis, hand drafting, and digital programming.

### **Costume Construction**

The theory and practice of the construction, finishing, and handling of costumes for productions and the entertainment industry.

### Costume Lab

Students learn the rudiments of costume repair and maintenance, the etiquette of costumes backstage, and the technical problems and procedures surrounding the costuming of a show.

### Makeup Lab

Students gain skills in the use of proper tools and procedures for applying stage makeup for both small and large stage productions.

### **Advanced Stage Management**

Advanced study in the methods and execution of stage management. Students will go through the complete process of production, stage management responsibilities, and relationships with production and administrative staff. Many projects and presentations.

### COMMERCIAL MUSIC PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

### A. CORE COURSES

### Music Theory

Designed to teach students the basic through advanced level components of music composition, melodic practices, theories of harmony, rhythmic practices, and other musical concepts inherent in all music. Students analyze and listen to music from traditional stylistic periods through contemporary styles including jazz, pop, rock, folk, country, hip-hop, gaming, and film. A thorough review of the key musical elements of melody, rhythm, harmony, and form in each musical style is emphasized.

### Ear Training/Improvisation

Designed to work in connection with Music Theory. Ear training explores sounds, melodies, harmonies, rhythms and formal structures through listening and developing a comprehension of musical elements aurally. Dictation of those elements is central to these courses as well as learning to improvise the elements learned from aural training. Styles ranging from classic standards to many of the commercial styles are explored with a thorough development of Jazz, pop, and rock forms.

### Music History/Commercial Music/Contemporary Styles

Designed to teach students the basic elements, principles, processes, materials, and inherent qualities of music. Students will examine a broad range of traditional musical styles as they analyze the processes involved in creating music. A study of the connections between music and societal movements will be an integral part of these courses. Music History encompasses many of the contemporary genres including Jazz, pop, rock, hip-hop, folk, evolution of the pop song, film and orchestral styles.

### **Applied Lesson**

All students enrolled in a music program take a weekly private, one-on-one lesson with an instructor in their chosen area of study, whether it be vocal or instrumental. Lessons range from 30-60 minutes weekly and are designed to focus on developing proper technique in the student along with advanced training in musicianship and preparation for performances and on-stage experiences. Repertoire in a variety of styles will be explored initially with an emphasis on commercial forms and contemporary styles as the student advances.

### Ensemble

Students select vocal and/or instrumental ensembles each semester from an array of commercial styles including jazz, pop, rock, and country. Students will demonstrate an ability to apply the fundamentals and techniques of each of these styles through productions and performances. Regular performances in a variety of settings is part of all ensemble study. Skills including sight-reading, improvisation, and performance techniques will be explored thoroughly in solo, small, and large ensemble settings. Critique and reflection of performances are integral.

### **B. TECHNOLOGY & COMPOSITION COURSES**

### **Digital Musicianship**

Designed for the study of technologies used to create, manipulate, perform, record, and share music. The course will introduce the student to the constantly changing digital resources available to them for music production, composition, and expression. Students will be introduced to basic synthesizer operations, concepts of MIDI and audio sequencing, editing, and playback, and a study of DAW(Digital Audio Workstation).

### **Computer Music Notation**

Designed to instruct students in how to prepare music manuscripts, both vocal and instrumental, through the use of computer notation programs. Various software programs will be explored.

### **Computer Production**

The focus of this class is for students to gain more advanced skills in the operation of the Digital Audio Workstation. Emphasis will be placed on mastering MIDI, synthesizer programming, sequencing, and arranging, and a study of both the technical and aesthetic aspects of production will be explored.

### **Sound Synthesis**

Students will study how to navigate hardware and software-based sound synthesizers. The course will focus on functions and components of synthesized sound and the techniques used to generate those sounds.

### **Recording Engineering**

An overview of the field of audio engineering technology. Attention will be given to foundational concepts, terminology, and the use of audio technology in art, entertainment, science, and engineering.

### **Audio Sound Production**

This course introduces the student to auditory perception, psychoacoustics, and hearing science as it relates to audio engineering, sound recording, and music production.

### Film Recording & Mixing

Students will learn to record and mix dialogue and sound effects for film using advanced technology in order to produce a final product.

### **Composing for Media**

Students will be introduced to composing, arranging, and orchestrating music for film and various other forms of media. Emphasis will be placed on compositional techniques, the logistics of incorporating the Digital Audio Workstation, and artist considerations of music in a supporting role.

### **Commercial Composition**

Students in the Commercial Music Program may choose the Composition track. This track focuses on the business of how to write music whether instrumental or vocal. The basic elements of melody, harmony, rhythm, and form are explored in traditional forms as well as the commercial styles including media and film.

### Song Writing

Designed to instruct students in the creation of songs in various popular styles including the commercial jingle. The class will explore styles of jazz, pop, rock, country, and other prominent popular styles.

### Orchestration

Part of the Music Composition track, orchestration explores how to write music for an orchestra, how to write for each instrument, how to assign musical parts for the instruments, and how to use the instruments together in an orchestral style. The course also includes how to adapt music written for another medium to orchestra. Beginning with the study of the classics, classes will focus on commercial styles, film scoring, and contemporary orchestration.

### **Contemporary Arranging**

Part of the Music Composition track, music arranging focuses on teaching students how to take a piece of music and arrange it for something other than what it was originally written for while maintaining the integrity and identity of the music. Students will learn how to arrange vocal songs into instrumental forms, how to arrange for small and large ensembles, and how to adjust basic musical elements of melody, rhythm, and harmony without losing the integrity of the original composition.

### Film Scoring

A course designed to introduce students to the art of film scoring which includes both arranging and newly composed music. By the end of the course, students will be able to score a short film using a sequencing platform and one of the standard notation programs.

### C. PERFORMANCE COURSES

### **Studio/Performance Class**

This class provides students an opportunity to perform in a small group setting within their own musical area of study with feedback from instructor and students. Elements of improvisation, stylistic interpretation, stage presence, cultural context, and pedagogical techniques are explored. Students will cover a wide variety of commercial music styles.

### **Sectionals**

Sectionals provide the students the opportunity to practice and rehearse together within their own musical section (ex. Percussion, guitar, altos, sopranos, etc). Specific techniques and musical elements are thoroughly rehearsed and mastered as preparation for performance for the entire ensemble.

### **Chamber Ensemble**

Students select a small-group vocal and/or instrumental ensemble each semester from an array of commercial styles including jazz, pop, rock, and country. Students will demonstrate an ability to apply the fundamentals and techniques of each of these styles through productions and performances. Regular performances in a variety of settings is part of all ensemble study.

### Instrumental Styles

A study of the major styles of commercial music with a focus on the characteristics that distinguish each style including instrumentation and key musical stylistic elements.

### **Evolution of Pop Song**

A detailed study of the pop song in its various styles including music jingles for commercials. Key musical elements that are inherent in the pop song will be studied.

### Commercial Keyboard

A skills based piano course focusing on the analysis of pop/rock keyboard performance providing a practical approach to playing in a variety of popular styles.

### DANCE PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

### **Ballet**

Ballet classes are designed to explore the foundational elements and techniques of ballet and progress to advanced levels of classical ballet training.

### Tap

Tap classes begin with an introduction to the basic tap dance techniques and progress to advanced tap.

### **Modern Dance**

Modern Dance begins with foundational studies of human movement as an art form with focus on developing strength, flexibility, and coordination. A variety of modern and contemporary dance forms are explored including an overview of world dance forms.

### Jazz

Jazz classes begin with an introduction to American Jazz dance styles and techniques and advances to a variety of Jazz styles including contemporary, lyric, and classical.

### **History of Dance**

History of Dance is designed to study the basic elements, principles, processes, and inherent qualities of dance from early forms to popular modern styles. Students will explore a broad range of methods and dance styles and will conduct critical analyses of the creative processes involved in each dance style. They will gain a thorough understanding of connections between society and dance in order to better understand dance origins and the evolution of dance from classic forms to commercial dance today.

### Improvisation/Composition/Choreography

Students will explore the rhythmic and spatial elements that go into designing dance movements and use improvisation as a tool for this exploration. Students will also expand their choreography skills through a focus on small group work. Short works of 2 of more dancers will be created and performed.

### Language of Dance

An introductory course to the language of dance from its origins to modern and commercial dance. Students will study the language and learn to speak the language of various dance styles and the technical terms associated with dance styles and particular dance movements.

### **Musical Theatre Dance**

An introduction to dance styles from the Renaissance to the present-day including dances of the folk, court, social, and theatrical traditions, with focus on their adaptation to performance and theatre. Particular attention will be placed upon dance forms trending in modern Broadway musical theatre.

### **Commercial Dance**

Designed to prepare students for the industry of dance. Students will learn dance trends in film, marketing, theatre, and other commercial forms that use dance and movement.

### **Anatomy & Kinesiology**

Students will study the science of movement in the human body as it relates to dance. Topics include the musculoskeletal system, the mechanism of muscular contraction, and developmental anatomy. Dancers learn to visualize, interpret, and document their movements as they gain a better understanding of how the body moves.

### **Pilates/Strength Training**

Designed to improve flexibility, build strength, and develop control and endurance in the entire body through a variety of exercises and techniques. Emphasis is placed on alignment, breathing, developing a strong core, and coordination and balance. The core focuses on the abdominal muscles, low back, and hips for strengthening and better dance control.

### **Performing Company**

The Company focuses on intense study and rehearsal. Students explore the dance experience and the elements needed for concert dance performance. This course provides an atmosphere in which students are nurtured and stimulated in their quest for artistic achievement, technical mastery, and scholarly excellence. Dance styles of all types are explored in the company with many opportunities for performance each year. Ensemble work and production are core ingredients in the study.

### **Dance Health**

A class designed to focus on the health of the dancer. Topics covered included hygiene, injury prevention, injury treatment, stress management, sports nutrition, eating disorders, and athletic performance.

### **Entertainment Career Prep**

An examination of issues that are important to the personal and professional career of a dancer. Topics include resume and image development, auditioning strategies, and sources for job opportunities.

### Introduction to Theatrical Design

An introductory class to the world of stage and theatrical design. Elements of study include scenery, costuming, lighting, projections, and properties. Students will gain a basic understanding of the design process behind on stage performing.

### **Stage Production Management**

A course designed to give students the background and skills necessary to function as an effective organizational manager throughout an on-stage production. Topics include the production process, rehearsal and performance procedures, auditions, communication, and organization.

For the past several months, we have been reviewing educational models to ensure that we are moving in the best direction for CSA. We have formally filed a Letter of Intent to become a public Charter School. The Charter will be a specialized performing arts high school for students in grades 9-12 to attend all day.

The title, Institute for the Creative Arts, has not changed, just the process for becoming a performing arts school that provides high school credit. We anticipate a start date of Fall 2024. Programs in the Institute will include, music, theatre, dance, visual art, film, writing, and culinary, along with a complete set of core academic courses.

Several families have expressed interest in becoming part of the half-day Institute that we originally planned to offer this

Fall. With the new *Learns Act* passed under Governor Sanders, the all-day Charter model has become the best route for CSA to go.

This coming school year CSA will continue to offer all of our current programs but will not begin the Institute until the following school year after the Charter has been approved. I am pleased to report that the Institute as well as our current afterschool programs will be housed in our new facility, the Center for the Creative Arts located at 1101 Riverfront Drive. The Center is expected to be ready for move-in later this year. We plan to offer our current programs in the new facility by the Spring '24 semester. We will continue to be housed at St. Boniface this Summer and Fall.

### Community School of the Arts seeks to open performing arts high school

Community School of the Arts in Fort Smith is taking steps to become the first performing arts high school in Arkansas. If the charter is approved, the school would be open for 9-12 grade students and could open in the fall of 2024.

The program, which is building a 40,000-square-foot Center for Creative Arts on the Arkansas River next to the U.S. Marshals Museum on Riverfront Drive in Fort Smith, recently filed a letter of intent with the Arkansas Department of Education Charter School Office to submit an application for an open enrollment public charter school to be called the Institute for the Creative Arts.

Recent legislation signed by Gov. Sarah Sanders promoting speciality schools and school choice led the Community School of the Arts to change plans from offering half or partial day opportunities to for high school students wishing to pursue more education in the arts to opening a full-day school for students in ninth through 12th grades, said Dr. Rosilee Russell, founder and executive director.

"We really want to have a high school for the performing arts propelled for specialized education, and we realized a charter school was the way to go. We want to prepare our students for college and beyond," Walker said, noting the school will offer all the core academic courses students need to graduate.

She said CSA administration would work with the state to substitute some classes for core requirements, giving the example that an acting class could be substituted for a speech class.

"But we of course will have all the core classes, math and science, and AP (advanced placement) courses. Many students gifted in the performing arts are gifted students in all areas. We want to provide what they need," Russell said.

If the charter is granted, the school would plan to open in the fall of 2024. A public hearing will be held at 6 p.m., May 11 at the U.S. Marshals Museum.

CSA broke ground March 17, 2021, on a new facility near the museum on Riverfront Drive in Fort Smith. The land for the new school, 11 acres north of the museum, was donated to the school by the Robbie Westphal family. Construction of the building is expected to be complete later this year, Russell said, noting that the roof is supposed to go up this week. Administration plans to open the building for community classes in December or January.

The Center was initially planned by the state of the students and adults. While after school programs are still planned, earlier plans called for the Center to be home to specialized programs for high school students that would operate daily as students attend from regional school districts and receive high school credits at their participating school.

"We realized we have the space for a full-day high school," Russell said. "Arkansas does not have a performing arts high school. We will be able to offer things they couldn't get anywhere else."

She said CSA will continue to work with high schools throughout the area to be a positive thing for the area. Because it will have open enrollment, the school will be open to all high school students in the area, not just Fort Smith.

"To have something like this in Fort Smith should be a very positive thing for Fort Smith," Russell said.

A public charter receives state funding per student like any other public school.


If the charter is approved, Russell said CSA will begin the search for qualified instructors and teachers.

"We want teachers who are qualified to teach at the college level who want to teach high school students," she said.

The new 40,000-square-foot building on the river will include high-tech classrooms, teaching studios, art galleries, recording studio, film and digital animation labs, dance studios, culinary labs, black box theater and a 350-seat theater and performance hall. Russell said they have been able to raise more than \$10 million for the building's capital campaign. This year they are working to raise up to \$3 million.

"We separate it up in pieces, so it doesn't seem too overwhelming. Fundraising is continuous," she said.







# 2023 Open-Enrollment Charter Applicant State of Assurances

The signature of the President of the Board of Directors of the proposed public charter school's sponsoring entity certifies that the following statements are and will be addressed through policies adopted by the sponsoring entity and policies to be adopted by the public charter school; and, if the application is approved, that the sponsoring entity, governing body, administration, and staff of the open-enrollment charter shall abide by them.

- 1. The information submitted in this application is true to the best of my knowledge and belief, and this application has been sent to the superintendent of all the districts from which we expect to draw students.
- 2 The open-enrollment public charter school shall be open to all students, on a space-available basis, and shall not discriminate in its admission policy on the basis of gender, national origin, race, ethnicity, religion, disability, or academic or athletic eligibility, except as follows: the open-enrollment public charter school may adopt admissions policies that are consistent with federal law, regulations, or guidelines applicable to charter schools. The charter may provide for the exclusion of a student who has been expelled from another public school district.
- 3. If enrollment exceeds the approved enrollment cap, the open-enrollment charter school shall hold an annual random and anonymous public lottery, followed with notifying parents of enrollment status for all applicants. The waiting list generated by the lottery will be maintained for one year.
- 4. In accordance with federal and state laws, the open-enrollment public charter school hiring and retention policies of administrators, teachers, and other employees shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, sex, ethnicity, sexual orientation, mental or physical disability, age, ancestry, or special need.
- 5. The open-enrollment public charter school shall operate in accordance with federal laws and rules governing public schools, applicable provisions of the Arkansas Constitution, and state laws and regulations governing public schools not waived by the approved charter.
- 6. The open-enrollment public charter school shall not use the moneys that it receives from the state for any sectarian program or activity, or as collateral for debt.
- Open-enrollment public charter schools may enter into lease-purchase agreements for school buildings built by private entities with facilities bonds exempt from federal taxes under 26 USCS 142(a) as allowed by Ark. Code Ann.

- § 6-20-402. No indebtedness of an open-enrollment public charter school shall ever become a debt of the State of Arkansas.
- 8. The open-enrollment public charter school shall not impose taxes or charge students tuition or fees that would not be allowable charges in the public school districts.
- 9. The open-enrollment public charter school shall not be religious in its operations or programmatic offerings.
- 10. The open-enrollment public charter school shall ensure that any of its employees who qualify for membership in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System or the Arkansas State and Public School Employee Insurance Program shall be covered under those systems to the same extent a qualified employee of a traditional school district is covered.
- 11. The employees and volunteers of the open-enrollment public charter school are held immune from liability to the same extent as other public school district employees and volunteers under applicable state laws.
- 12. The open-enrollment public charter school shall be reviewed for its potential impact on the efforts of a public school district or public school districts to comply with court orders and statutory obligations to create and maintain a unitary system of desegregated public schools.
- 13. The open-enrollment public charter school shall comply with all health and safety laws, rules and regulations of the federal, state, county, region, or community that may apply to the facilities and school property.
- 14. The applicant confirms the understanding that certain provisions of state law shall not be waived. The open-enrollment public charter school is subject to any prohibition, restriction, or requirement imposed by Title 6 of the Arkansas Code and any rule and regulation approved by the State Board of Education under this title relating to:
  - (a) Monitoring compliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 6-23-101 et seq., as determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Education;
  - (b) Conducting criminal background checks for employees;
  - (c) High school graduation requirements as established by the State Board of Education;
  - (d) Special education programs as provided by this title;
  - (e) Public school accountability under this title;
  - (f) Ethical guidelines and prohibitions as established by Ark. Code Ann. § 6-24- 101 et seq., and any other controlling state or federal law regarding ethics or conflicts of interest; and
  - (g) Health and safety codes as established by the State Board of Education and state and local governmental entities.

- 15. The facilities of the public charter school shall comply with all requirements for accessibility for individuals with disabilities in accordance with the ADA and IDEA and all other state and federal laws.
- 16. Should the open-enrollment public charter school voluntarily or involuntary close, the applicant confirms the understanding that any fees associated with the closing of the school including, but not limited to, removal of furniture, equipment, general expenses, etc., are the sole responsibility of the sponsoring entity. No indebtedness of any kind incurred or created by the open-enrollment public charter school shall constitute an indebtedness of the state or its political subdivisions, and no indebtedness of the openenrollment public charter school shall involve or be secured by the faith, credit, or taxing power of the state or its political subdivisions. Upon dissolution of the openenrollment public charter school or upon nonrenewal or revocation of the charter, all net assets of the open- enrollment public charter school, including any interest in real property, purchased with public funds shall be deemed the property of the state, unless otherwise specified in the charter of the open-enrollment public charter school. If the open-enrollment public charter school used state or federal funds to purchase or finance personal property, real property or fixtures for use by the open-enrollment public charter school, the authorizer may require that the property be sold. The state has a perfected priority security interest in the net proceeds from the sale or liquidation of the property to the extent of the public funds used in the purchase.
- 17. To be eligible for a charter school license, an entity must hold or have applied for 501(c)(3) status at the time this charter application is filed. The entity must receive formal tax exempt status under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 prior to the first day of its operation with students.
- 18. Any applications submitted without documentation showing that 501(c)(3) status has been applied for or received will not be reviewed. Articles of incorporation or a letter acknowledging non-profit status from the Secretary of State will not suffice.
- 19. The curriculum used in the school will be aligned to the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education curriculum standards.
- 20. The Arkansas Public School Computer Network (APSCN) Financial Management System, provided by the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, shall be the original and official accounting systems of record for the public charter school as required by state law and the rules and regulations of the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education for all financial transaction records and reporting (including, but not limited to, payroll processing and wage and tax reporting to the IRS ATRS, DFA, etc., accounts payable, fixed assets, personnel budgeting, and budgeting). APSCN shall be used to record all private, as well as, local, state, and federal revenues and expenditures.
- 21. Ark. Code Ann.§6-24-105 prohibits charter school board members from contracting with or being employed by the charter school except in certain limited circumstances.
- 22. The Arkansas Public School Computer Network (APSCN) Financial Management System, provided by the Department of Education, shall be the original and official accounting system of record for the public charter school as required by state law and the rules and regulations of the Department of Education for all financial transaction

records and reporting (including, but not limited to, payroll processing and wage and tax reporting to IRS, ATRS, DFA, etc., accounts payable, fixed assets, personnel budgeting, and budgeting). APSCN shall be used to record all private, as well as, local, state, and federal revenues and expenditures.

- 23. The Arkansas Public School Computer Network (APSCN) Student Management System, provided by the Department of Education, shall be the original and official student management system for the public charter school as required by state law and the rules and regulations of the Department of Education for all student management areas (including, but not limited to, systems administration, demographics, attendance, scheduling, report cards, discipline, medical, Cognos reporting, and Statewide Information System reporting).
- 24. The facility to be used will be in compliance with all requirements for accessibility in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and all other state and federal laws and local zoning ordinances.
- 25. A copy of the entity's letter from the IRS reflecting tax exempt status or a copy of the entity's application for 501(c)(3) status must be included with the application. Articles of incorporation or a letter acknowledging non-profit status from the Secretary of State will not suffice.) To be eligible, an entity must hold or have applied for 501(c)(3) status at the time this charter application is filed. The entity must receive formal tax exempt status under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 prior to the first day of its operation with students. Non-profit entities without the required Internal Revenue Service documentation are not eligible to be awarded charters; therefore, any applications submitted without documentation showing that 501(c)(3) status has been applied for or received will not be reviewed.
