04-JL-0503-2024	Alpena	Released to	59-year-old female who presented to the ED with pain and weakness. Decedent was then admitted for further care. Decedent has a history of adenocarcinoma of the stomach, dehydration, chronic abdominal pain, radiation gastritis and malignant neoplasm of the stomach. Today she was diagnosed with septic shock, pneumonia, hypomagnesemia, hypokalemia and heart failure. Decedent declined during care and went into cardiac arrest. Family then put her on comfort care. Dr. Wagner reviewed the circumstances of the case. Cause of death is complications of adenocarcinoma of the stomach. The manner is natural.
