We also had representatives from the village who helped students with basic bike maintenance. Through various donations, we were able to outfit students with proper fitting helmets if their families signed up to receive one. We had 26 students receive a free helmet. All students who participated in the bike rodeo had a proper fitting helmet by the end of the event.

All together the unit was highly successful with students getting to engage in a variety of learning opportunities about the sky and space. We even had students participate in a Win a Rocket writing contest in which the winning handwritten essays got to receive a real rocket.
