If you are a public school teacher (not charter nor magnet), you may apply for up to \$600. Your Principal's expressed approval of the project is necessary. (If you are returning a paper copy of your application, mail to the above address, keeping copies for your Principal and for your own records.)

PROPOSAL details:

1. What is something that you would like very much to do for or with your students but you cannot currently afford to do it?

I would like to purchase a large loom for multiple children to learn and use weaving skills. This loom is large and solid, made from maple and has a 30x48 work area. This loom is for weaving with real tapestry materials.

2. In 200 words or less, describe this project, listing the estimated costs of the items of the planned project totaling up to \$600.

"The Friendly Loom" from Sax arts, \$ 394.79

This is a large loom with adjustable height which can allow up to eight students to weave at the same time. Students improve fine motor skills, build creative skills in fiber arts and build hand eye coordination. Building these fine motor skills with repetitive tasks helps all children with diagrammatic thinking found at the highest levels of geometry and physics. It is a valuable tool to have handy in the repertoire of art room equipment. If other monies are available, I would love to purchase a box of yarn and 2 packages of long weaving needles.


