D. Summary:

Coordinated School Health Programs (CSHP) are designed to prevent obesity, cardiovascular disease, and Type 2 diabetes in elementary school, middle school, and junior high school students. Each program must coordinate health education, oral health education, physical education, physical activity, nutrition services, and parental involvement.

Chapter 38 of the Texas Education Code mandates districts implement a CSHP in elementary through junior high schools.

The School Health Advisory Council reviewed the three options and recommends the Board approve "CATCH" (Coordinated Approach to Child Health) as the designated Robstown ISD CSHP.

Additionally, it is recommended the Board approve CATCH My Breath as the Vape Prevention Program.

E. Alternatives Considered: Two programs approved by TEA- The Great Body Shop and Bienestar

G. Administrative Recommendation: The Board review and approve CATCH as the designated Robstown ISD CSHP for elementary and junior high campuses and CATCH My Breath as the Vape Prevention Program for Seale Junior High School.
