FEEDBACK FROM BONNEVILLE COUNTY

Here is some feedback from Bonneville County (I asked them because of their large size and experience)

Elections Clerk - Penny:

- They can't determine if it is legal. We have to seek legal and/or bond counsel
- it was Hawley Troxell that helped District #93 with their bond ballot wording
- Voter Confusion is the #1 problem with the bond questions
- keep it simple
- election workers cannot help with ballot questions on election day

County Clerk – Ron (has worked 36 years as clerk)

- can't say if legal or not – seek outside counsel
- be realistic with your questions
- no 'pie in the sky' questions
- no 'let's see what happens' questions
- But, Dist #93 and new Jail took 3 tries each, can't start with bare bones unless nowhere to go
- simple and clear options worked well for Dist #93
