<b>Rationale</b>	<p>The Texas Education Code requires the development of a "juvenile justice alternative education program" by the juvenile board of a county with a population of 125,000. In 1995, the Brazoria County Juvenile Board and the eight school districts throughout Brazoria County entered into an agreement establishing the Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program. The Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department provides juvenile probation officers, advisors, support staff and the physical facility necessary to operate the program.</p>
