## **DESCRIPTION:**

Here is a brief look back at Community Education Summer Programs over the past four years and a summary of how they have evolved, progressed and improved over the years.

**2008** -Last official year of Summer School supported by 01 fund.

**2009**- Summer School program was eliminated due to a failed levy and budget cuts. We offered the first summer *Sun Block* enrichment classes, held at Discovery Center (due to construction at BCMS).

**2010**- We combined *Sun Block* with the Kid Kare program, and for the first time, offered centralized transportation from each elementary school in the District. Classes were offered once again at BCMS.

**2011**- Year two of *Sun Block* combined with Kid Kare. This was also the first year we started a Targeted Services summer program for remedial reading, math and ELL.

**2012**- Community Education will once again offer a full menu of summer activities. This includes: a Targeted Services remedial reading, math and ELL "referral only" program. This year, we are also excited to incorporate and use the new BCMS tennis courts in the *Sun Block* program. We are going to continue the 10 and Under USTA tennis program that we started this winter.

We are also are working to improve upon our marketing efforts for Community Education summer programs. We have been working with Carlson Marketing Team to develop an overall marketing strategy. We also have new marketing materials that I will have for you at the meeting.
