Subject: Consent Calendar – New purchase for Maintenance Machinery

The Maintenance Supervisor requests approval for the purchase of a, Homag Drillteq D – 200/060 12 Drill and Dowel Machine. With this machinery requested it will allow the mill shop to increase production turnaround time. It will eliminate steps taken by machinery and manpower and provide a more simplistic assembly of millwork without sacrificing integrity. The machinery requested will also allow for parts to be labeled as they exist the CNC cutting process and save time and manpower trying to locate different parts to assemble mill work. It will also allow for quicker assembly with drill and dowel fastener construction in several ways. Also, this will allow for the to transition to a European style hinge to a line with industry standards. It will become easier to develop the craftsmanship skills of those newly hired, and allow for quick assembly with only one universal fastener. The cost of the machine is \$64,990.00. The Homag Drillteq D 200/060 along with cordless bar code reader is \$2,136.00. The additional items needed for this machine such as the CNC label station, installation, label creator, power supply integration to CNC and label Ribbon. The cost of these is \$6,890.00. The total cost of this machine will be \$74,016.00. Funding for this machine will come from District Maintenance and Operations Budget for fiscal year 2024-2025.
