Item Title: Approve SSAISD Lone Star Governance Constraint Measures to ensure high quality instruction and comprehensive support services in South San Antonio ISD

Constraint Progress Measures

Constr. 1

The Superintendent will not allow the absence rate to increase or remain the same.

Progress Measures

- 1.1: The student absence rate will not exceed 6% in 2017-2018.
- 1.2: The teacher absence rate will not exceed 6% in 2017-2018.

Constraint Progress Measures

Constr. 2

The Superintendent will not allow any campuses to have inequitable access to effective staff.

Progress Measures

- 2.1: Counselors will increase their time directly interacting with students from 30% to 50% by 2017-2018.
- 2.2: School site-based funding (decentralized budget) will be piloted in 2018-2019 and fully implemented by all campuses in 2019-2020.
- 2.3: Administration will ensure a clear and defined improvement plan for teachers who need additional support by 2017-2018 to meet student outcomes.

Constraint Progress Measures

Constr. 3

The Superintendent will not propose a change of use for a functioning campus unless the board has adopted a long-term facilities plan that is developed by a structured process for gathering and incorporating the community's values and ideas.

Progress Measures

3.1 The superintendent will monitor enrollment and increase "academic choice program" options to all middle school students by Spring 2018.

3.2 The superintendent will engage a committee of community members before a long-term facilities plan is presented to the board.
