District Leadership Team

- We have a district leadership team that consists of two teachers and the principal from each building, federal programs director, and superintendent. The team met in April and focused on priorities in the areas of curriculum, professional development, and school safety. We will meet again at the end of this month to continue our efforts.

Positive Behavior Intervention Supports - PBIS

- The PBIS leadership team which is made up of two to three staff members per building met with Boise State Staff and received training in the area of cognitive coaching. These skills will be utilized to help implement PBIS district-wide. This is part of the RK-12 grant that we will utilize over the next three years.

New Idaho Reading Indicator - IRI

- Idaho is transitioning to a new IRI by ISTATON. This is a computer adaptive test for grades K-3. It is a comprehensive assessment system with a screener, diagnostic, and progress monitoring components. Test results are delivered immediately. Four staff members will attend a workshop in June to put together an implementation plan for the new IRI.
