Breakfast Program Resolution

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District adopt the attached resolution in regard to the Breakfast Program.

RATIONALE:

ITEM: VI.B.

TOPIC:

In order to be in compliance with Section 380.1272 of the School Code as amended in December 1993, the School Board must operate a school breakfast program or opt out following state guidelines.

It is recommended that Livonia Public Schools opt out of offering a breakfast program for the 2010-11 school year except at Cleveland, Coolidge, Cooper, Garfield, Grant, Hayes, Johnson, and Rosedale Elementary Schools; Emerson Middle School, Frost Middle School, Churchill High School, Franklin High School, Western Wayne Skill Center and the Northwest Trainable Center at Webster School where 20% of the student enrollment qualifies for free or reduced price lunches. The remaining students at Webster Elementary School will have breakfast offered to them because these students come from school districts that offer a breakfast program. Stevenson High School will offer a breakfast program because the Stevenson staff is available to facilitate the program in the morning.
