
Discuss and consider the use of ESSER funds to purchase Edgenuity on-line instruction for credit recovery and academic acceleration for Ball High School and AIM College and Career Prep.

GISD administration is requesting permission to continue use of Edgenuity, a standards-based curriculum and intervention program, for students in grades 6-12 who need the opportunity to recover credits or to accelerate. Virtual classroom and Virtual Tutor solutions engage students in the learning process through animation, simulations, video-based presentations, online content, vocabulary and exploration activities that support each lesson presented by a Highly Qualified Virtual Classroom Teacher. The cost is \$117,000 for a two-year contract (ending August 31, 2023). The district is requesting approval of ESSER funds for this purchase due to the states decrease in IMA funding.


