

Description:

School Board Application for Study Recruitment: Rescue Agency and G+G Advertising

With this email, I have attached a Discussion Group Overview, which outlines the aims of the project as well as the type of support/role we are hoping Browning School District (namely Browning High School and Buffalo Hide Academy) will agree to. To clarify, we are asking for school support to recruit youth ages 13-17 years old, over the course of a few days during the week of September 22, 2019. Recruitment activities would be implemented by our project staff and would only take place on school campuses during non-academic times (i.e., lunch periods) or when indicated as most convenient for school staff.

This research is completely voluntary for schools and youth. If permission is provided, the plan is for recruitment staff to introduce themselves to youth and explain that they will be holding discussion groups where youth will be asked to share opinions about future commercials/campaign materials. If the youth is interested and available, a recruiter will explain that participants are selected via a paper and pen Screener survey that they can take immediately following the expression of interest in the study. The Screener survey is attached to this email and is expected to take no more than 5 minutes to complete. Following recruitment activities, project staff will review Screener responses and identify eligible youth to be invited to participate in one of the three discussion groups to be hosted in Browning, MT.

As a reminder, this project and its materials have been reviewed and approved by both an independent and Federal IRB. Documentation of our IRB approvals and status can be found in

the attached folder. Additionally, we are pending approval from the Blackfeet Nation IRB board, and we will be sure to keep you updated on the status of this approval.

We are so grateful for your support and willingness to help present this to the School Board. Please let me know if there is any additional information I can provide and/or if you have any questions or concerns.
