- 2024–2025 Closed out
- 2025–2026 Grant Cycle Update

The 2024–2025 GEAR UP grant cycle has formally concluded. All required programmatic activities have been completed, and fiscal and performance reporting is being finalized in accordance with grant requirements.

The 2025–2026 GEAR UP grant cycle began on November 1, 2025. Program implementation is currently underway, with a comprehensive calendar of activities scheduled through the conclusion of the school year. Planned activities are aligned with grant objectives and designed to address identified student needs related to college and career readiness.

The second semester represents a high-activity period for the program, with a primary focus on dual enrollment outreach, student advising, registration assistance, and required orientation sessions. These efforts are essential to supporting student access to postsecondary coursework and credential opportunities.

Dual enrollment registration and orientation were scheduled for Tuesday, January 20. A follow-up update will be provided once registration and orientation are complete to report final student participation numbers and ensure accurate program documentation.

GEAR UP services will continue to prioritize postsecondary awareness, academic preparedness, and successful transition planning through coordinated efforts with students, families, school staff, and postsecondary partners.
