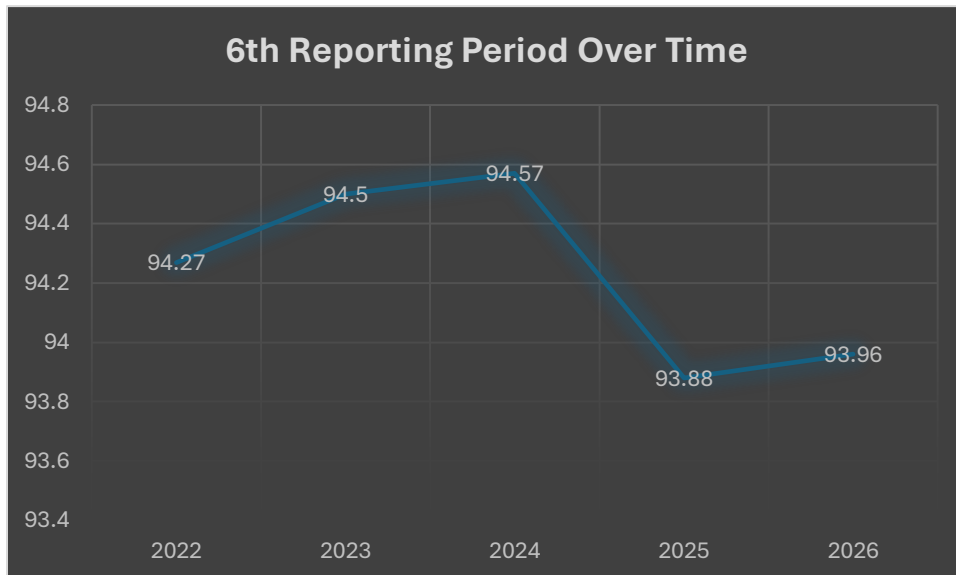

Trend Analysis

- Overall, Denton ISD slightly improved ADA in RP 6 from last year to this year, from 93.88% to 93.96%.
 - Out of 25 elementary schools, 9 improved ADA in RP 6, with the largest increase being Borman Elementary (+2.06%).
 - Out of the 9 middle schools, 4 improved ADA in RP 6, with Crownover having the largest increase (+1.69%).
 - Three of the four comprehensive high schools saw improvement in ADA (Denton, Guyer, and Ryan).
 - Fred Moore also improved from 85.01% to 85.11%

Key Observations

- Even though the district saw improvement from last year's RP 6 to this year's, this year was the second lowest ADA in the past 6 years.
 - Secondary schools showed the most improvement from last year to this year.
 - According to our Truancy Dropout Prevention System (TDPS), the most missed days of the week are Thursdays and Fridays.
