

Subject: "Safe Routes to School" Bridge Project

Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

We are currently preparing plans for a "Safe Routes to School" project on FM 673, in the vicinity of Moreno Junior Middle School. This project proposes to accommodate pedestrian movement to and from the school. Our project proposes to add a 5' raised sidewalk with a six inch curb that would begin at Walton Street on the East side of FM 673, continuing across the Poesta Creek Bridge, and then cross FM 673 at the School's property line.

Due to the limited space in our right-of-way and the existing roadside ditch it would be favorable to place part of the sidewalk on school property adjacent to the post-cable fence. Please see the attached preliminary layout. This sidewalk would then continue to follow the property line up to the first entrance of the school.

In addition we plan to relocate the present crosswalk at Walton Street that is now in a 50 mph zone to the proposed crossing at the school's property line where the student/parents would cross in a protected school zone.
