BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The district instructional data dashboard provides the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district instructional focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.
- The Curriculum & Instruction Department will provide the Board with a math teaching and learning update.
- During the 2023-2024 school year, the Math Department has focused on bridging achievement gaps in mathematics, enhancing student engagement, and increasing postsecondary readiness as follows:
 - <u>Vertical and Horizontal Alignment</u>: Aligning curriculum coherence across grade levels to ensure seamless progression and consistency within each level.
 - Student-Centered Coaching Cycles: Cultivating a collaborative atmosphere conducive to academic advancement.
 - <u>Learner Engagement:</u> Implementing instructional strategies aimed at igniting curiosity and active participation.
 - <u>Postsecondary Readiness in Math:</u> Analyzing student data, providing targeted math intervention and increasing college readiness initiatives.
