Subject: Consider Approval of the Renewal of the Rover Program at the Elementary Schools

Background Information:

- During the 2022–23 school year, increased safety and security measures were implemented at Lewisville ISD campuses by establishing an elementary rover program in partnership with local law enforcement.
- The Elementary Rover Program was approved as an Action Item at the August 3, 2022, Board of Trustees workshop.
- On June 9, 2025, the Board of Trustees approved the ongoing 2025–2026 program and the estimated expenditures, allowing the rovers to be utilized by the District in the City of Lewisville.
- For the 2025–2026 school year, the City of Lewisville has been providing two police officers for the Rover program.
- The proposed number of Rovers
 - 2 - City of Lewisville
- If approved for the 2026–2027 school year, rovers would be utilized at the elementary campuses within the City of Lewisville. The Town of Flower Mound and the cities of Carrollton, Highland Village, and The Colony will utilize School Resource Officers for the elementary school campuses in their respective boundaries.

Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for these services will come from the Safety and Security budgets.
- Previous annual expenditures:
 - 2025–2026: \$258,182
- Estimated annual expenditures:
 - 2026–2027: \$265,000
- This procurement complies with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the ongoing Rover Program at the Elementary Schools located within the City of Lewisville for the 2026–2027 school year and the estimated annual expenditures.
