Subject: Strategic Plan Initiatives for 2021-2022

At the August 23rd regular meeting of the Board of Education, the four goal areas of the Strategic Plan were shared with specific initiatives. The four goals and initiatives of the Strategic Plan are:

- 1. <u>Whole Child Growth and Development</u>: District 13 will achieve success in maintaining a caring, supportive culture, engaging students in meaningful learning activities, and building positive and productive relationships utilizing a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS).
- 2. <u>Teaching and Learning</u>: District 13 will provide asynchronous flexible professional development opportunities to staff and opportunities for teams to engage in data analysis to support MTSS efforts.
- 3. <u>Communication and Collaboration</u>: District 13 will establish multiple committees/focus groups to create inclusionary opportunities for staff, administration, students, parents and citizens to provide feedback on initiatives, reports on progress made, and align communication efforts.
- 4. <u>Resources</u>: District 13 will develop a five-year financial plan with strategies and structures that will maintain a balanced budget by fund and an annual staffing plan based on instructional priorities.

As appropriate, the school improvement plans of each of the schools in the District will reflect the initiatives listed above. Presentations and reports on progress will be shared throughout the year culminating in the spring with a final presentation in May.
