<b>Summary:</b>	<p>The Texas Education Agency Office of School Safety and Security concluded in April a District Vulnerability Assessment of GCISD schools and district-level operations. The 187-page report is comprehensive. A summary was presented and reviewed with the Board of Trustees in closed session. The report was also reviewed in closed session with the District's Safety and Security Committee. The contents of the report must remain confidential. The District was praised by the lead agent for its practices and campus-level preparedness, and culture.</p> <p>This agenda item addresses Key Strategic Action 4.2.4: Sustain and evaluate systems of support to mitigate vulnerabilities and increase preparedness for emergencies and school safety.</p>
