Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District

2. Background:

Tax Code Section 26.09(e) states “the assessor shall enter the amount of tax determined as provided by this section in the appraisal roll and submit it to the governing body of the unit for approval. The appraisal roll with amounts of tax entered as approved by the governing body constitutes the unit's tax roll”

3. Process:

The Chief Appraisers of the Real County Appraisal District, the Uvalde County Appraisal District, and the Zavala County Appraisal District have certified and submitted their appraisal roll as approved by their respective Appraisal Review Boards, for calendar year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025, and have delivered to Rita C. Verstuyft, Tax Assessor Collector for the Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District, a statement of the total amount of appraised, assessed, and taxable value of property as of January 1, 2025.

Also included is the value for properties under protest at the time of submission for the assessment rolls lying within the Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District.

Rolls are provided for both the \$100,000 and \$140,000 exemption.
