# STAAR passing rates in **2019** continue to increase for all populations




# Denton ISD scored above the State average in all subject areas and performance standards




**70%** of the students achieved **Academic Growth (Progress)** on the 2019 STAAR assessments for Reading and Mathematics.

Met Progress




The **District** attendance rate had a slight dip, while the **State** rate is in further decline.

Of the 2018 graduates, **76.9%** received the **Recommended High School Program** or **Distinguished Achievement Program** diploma.






## Student Demographics




## Student Enrollment by Program




