Board Goal:

• The purpose of this item is to update the Board regarding the possibilities of a future ADSY calendar to support student learning.

<u>Objectives</u>

- Revisit the guidelines provided by TEA.
- Discuss benefits and possible concerns regarding ADSY.
- Share feedback received from elementary staff members through ThoughtExchange.
- Provide possible options for accelerating learning.

Operational Impact

• HB 3 provides ½ day funding for up to 30 additional school days, beyond 180 minimum days on approved calendar.

<u>Results</u>

Based upon current discussion and feedback received, the planning team recommends continued study prior to recommending when and how to best utilize the ADSY calendar.

Other Options

- Staff could be directed to consider use of "Jump Start" and "Summer School" for targeted students at multiple campuses using staff that opts in to serve.
- Staff could revisit the traditional ASY calendar to capture the 180 instructional days.
