Subject: Career and Technical Education Supplies, Equipment, Services, Curriculum and Other Related Products and Services – Cooperative Contract(s)

Background Information:

- This recommendation is for procurement options for LISD Career and Technical campuses and departments to supplement previously awarded LISD Bids RFP #2655(A-C)-20 Career and Technical Education Supplies, Equipment, Services, Curriculum and Other Related Products and Services, and RFP #F1073(A)-24 Career and Technical Education Supplies, Equipment, Services, Curriculum and Other Related Products and Services.
- By allowing the use of LISD-eligible cooperative contracts, LISD campuses and departments
 would be able to utilize the supplemental cooperative contract(s) throughout the year for
 related career and technical education supplies and equipment, including but not limited to
 LISD Agriculture, Culinary Arts, Wood Manufacturing, Automotive, Floral Design, and
 Horticulture/Plant Science program and any other classroom materials as needed districtwide for Pre-K-12th grade.
- If approved, the use of LISD-eligible cooperative contracts will grant the District access to a wide range of vendors, products, services, and pricing to help provide the best value.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include but are not limited to price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors.
- Interlocal Cooperative Contracts have gone through a competitive procurement process and comply with local, state, and federal procurement laws.

Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for these purchases will come from Board-approved campus budgets, bond funds, federal fund budgets, departmental budgets, general operating funds, and activity funds.
- Previous annual expenditures in this commodity:

o 2024-2025: \$1,501,610

- Estimated annual expenditures in this commodity: \$1,550,000 but will not exceed the approved budget(s).
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code and EDGAR 2 CFR 200.

Recommendations:

 That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the use of LISD-eligible cooperative contract(s) for Career and Technical Education Supplies, Equipment, Services, Curriculum and Other Related Products and Services, the associated vendors, and the estimated expenditures for one year.
