1. Sammie Lynn has been hired as the new High School Band Director. His resume is attached.
2. Skybeam contract finalized. The contract with Skybeam for the tower has been finalized at \$400 a month with the cost to the school for internet unchanged. The contract states that if terminated, the company will remove the tower and return the area to its former condition.
3. UIL results the Middle School came in 3rd in academics, HS has Colleen Betik in Headline Writing and Number Sense, and Mahailey Oliver in Ready Writing and Caculator advancing to Regionals, Middle School One-Act Play came in 2nd and High School One Act Play came in 3rd,
