DESCRIPTION:

Minnesota's new Multiple Measurements Ratings (MMR) for schools were released to the public May 22, 2012. The released MMR ratings are considered "initial designations" for each site as we transition to this new accountability system as a result of Minnesota's NCLB waiver.

The table below indicates the Multiple Measurements Rating (MMR) and the Focused Rating (FR) for each school in our district. An explanation of these scores is included in the attached MMR Brief prepared by Jack Brady, BHM District Assessment Coordinator.
