## Lisle Community Unit School District 202 Board of Education Meeting January 27, 2025

**SUBJECT:** Student Handbooks/Board Policy – Student Access to Mobile Phones

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Administration recommends continuing to follow the current protocols for student access to mobile phones during the school day.

**BACKGROUND DATA:** The Board of Education requested the Administration review the current Board Policy and Student Handbooks related to student access to mobile phones during school hours.

In general, students <u>may not</u> interact with their mobile phones during class without permission from a teacher. Students <u>may</u> use their mobile phones in the cafeteria during lunch or in the hallways during the passing periods

These expectations are outlined in the student handbook and shared verbally by the teaching staff.

Teachers will give a referral (with the below implication) to students unwilling to follow the mobile phone guidelines.
