**COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY NO. 4  
CONTRACT FOR COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES  
2014 - 2015**

This contract is provided in duplicate between the Board of Control of the **Cooperative Educational Service Agency No. 4**, party of the first part, and **Woneewoc-Union Center School District** party of the second part.

WHEREAS, party of the first part has been authorized to provide services for valuable consideration to school districts on a cooperative basis and has been authorized to enter into and approve service contracts with school districts and other agencies as authorized by Chapter 116, Wisconsin Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said party of the first part hereby agrees to deliver the following services:

1. Provide contracted services per Master Contract as outlined in 2014-2015 master contract.
2. File necessary plans and reports with State or Federal agencies.
3. File claim(s) for State and/or Federal Funds.
4. Forward Federal and/or State Funds which are due the participating school districts as soon as possible after the receipt of said funds.

CESA #4 hereby agrees to provide to the District services to be performed by legally qualified personnel. Information regarding expenditures, receipts, duration, and other matters pertaining to each service to be performed is included in the attached Master Contract. The Master Contract and addendums thereto are hereby incorporated in their entirety as part of this contract and may, by mutual written agreement be added to or deletions made. Details of the individual programs and services are outlined in the 2014-2015 CESA #4 Programs and Services Catalog (found on the CESA #4 website: [www.cesa4.k12.wi.us](http://www.cesa4.k12.wi.us))

CESA #4 and its sub-contractors agree to make payments to the personnel providing the services, and to remit to the authorized governmental or private agencies such amounts for which salary and all other deductions are required or authorized by Federal and Wisconsin Statutes.

All billings from party of the first part are based on a fee basis or actual costs except for special education itinerant and CESA #4 district-based personnel. In the case of special education itinerants, billings and payments are based on estimated costs. Fiscal adjustments will be refunded or collected no later than 60 days from the closing of the fiscal year. Any adjustments for district-based staff will also be made at year end.

The party of the second part agrees to pay in full quarterly pro rata for services rendered. Quarterly payments to be made in August, October, January, and April. The party of the second part agrees to pay its proportionate share of costs of the services provided under this agreement including but without limitation because of enumeration, unemployment compensation, litigation expense, collective bargaining and monetary awards by courts and agencies as per section 116.03(4). Transportation of children, if any, will be furnished by each school district unless otherwise specified by contract.

Both parties ensure compliance with Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972, Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, IDEA, the Wisconsin Fair Employment Act, The Wisconsin Pupil Non-Discrimination Law, Pupil Records Laws, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 and the Americans with Disabilities Act.
