Statement of reasons: For more than 30 years, the Texas school finance formula has remained substantially unchanged. It is the recommendation of the DISD that the state make appropriate budget adjustments to the school finance system by developing a simplified and sustainable plan, which provides resources promoting educational excellence for all Texas students. DISD further advocates for truth in taxation as it relates to the implications of rising property values and the corresponding decline in state funding for public education. In addition, DISD expects that the State shall not engage in any tax cuts until it has fully funded the infrastructures of the state; specifically, funding public education.
