BOARD MINUTES MARCH 24, 2010

CALL TO ORDER:

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 24th day of March, 2010 a Regular Meeting of the Crockett County Consolidated Common School District Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:42 pm by Board President Marcus Sims with a quorum of the following members present: Marcus Sims, Laurie Hale, Veronica Fierro, Dwight Childress, Grizz Medina, and Harvey Sanchez. Board Member Tom Anderson joined the meeting in progress at 7:19 pm. Also attending were Chris duBois, Melissa Perner, Cynthia Hokit, Keith Harmsen, Debra Bangeman, John Kain, Benny Granger, Houston Hendryx, Amanda Jackson, Robert Hernandez, Bill Baker, Doug Koehne, and Doris Hood. Numerous citizens, parents, and students also attended the meeting and were registered as guests.

INVOCATION:

Benny Granger offered the invocation.

APPROVE AGENDA:

A motion by Laurie Hale to approve the agenda for the March 24, 2010 Regular Meeting of the Board with omissions to agenda item numbers 9, 10, and 12. Also agenda items 5 and 6F would be moved to be presented following agenda item number 3. The motion was seconded by Veronica Fierro and passed 6-0.

PRESENTATION FROM CHEVRON CORPORATION: Cotey Coweykus, representing Chevron Corporation, presented a check in the amount of \$20,000 to Superintendent Chris duBois on behalf of the Crockett County CCSD. EBooks are to be purchased with the contribution from Chevron Corporation.

Debra Bangeman, High School Librarian Aide, and accompanying students presented a brief demonstration displaying some of the potential uses of the technology related to EBook readers.

OPEN FORUM AND PUBLIC COMMENTS:

During the Open Forum/Public Comments segment of the March 24, 2010 Regular Meeting of the Board several citizens, parents, and students presented their concerns or appreciation related to the district coaching staff, personnel contracts, and the athletic program. Action was not required.

8. Summer Institute:

SECONDARY: School System will send at least four (4) participants from each secondary school listed as "(new)" in the AVID Member Schools section of Attachment A. AVID Center recommends a site team include the principal, counselor, AVID coordinator, and core subject area teachers to an approved AVID Summer Institute. Recommended subject area teachers include English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, and World Languages.

The cost for Summer Institute regular registration is \$745.00 per participant. In exchange for School System signing and returning this Agreement on or before May 3, 2010, AVID Center will honor the discounted early bird registration fee of \$670.00 per participant. If School System signs and returns this Agreement after May 3, 2010, but before the respective Late Fee Start Date, the regular registration rate will apply. If School System has not signed and returned this Agreement on or before the respective Late Fee Start Date, the fee will increase from the regular cost of \$745.00 and an additional late fee of \$100.00 will be applied to all participants who attend the Summer Institute(s). School System understands that travel, lodging, and per diem costs are not included in the price of the registration fee.
