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1. **Call to order and Introductions:** Committee Chair Debra Guss called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and introductions were made.
2. **ECE Course Discrete Math.:** Next, Ms. Daniels provided an overview of a proposed class University of Connecticut Discrete Math Early College Education (“ECE”) class, which would be offered to Juniors and Seniors at Middletown High School and provide an additional high-level Math option for students. A discussion followed regarding, among other items, further details of the class, prerequisites, student interest, communications around, cost and timing for offering the class. A further discussion followed regarding ways to better communicate classes and pathways to support future post-high school studies and careers.
3. **Discussion on AP Science and Math Course.** Next, Ms. Hanly provided an overview of the timing and process for introducing new courses, highlighting that new courses for the following year need to be approved by the December BOE meeting of the preceding year. A discussion followed during which the timing was discussed in more detail, including the logistics for getting input from families and students, including a proposal to plan a parent Math workshop in the Fall.
4. **Adjournment:** Committee Chair Debra Guss then adjourned the meeting at 6:07 p.m.
