

Personnel Resignations and Recommendations

Background:

Under Iowa Code 279.12, the school board has the authority to employ teachers, other licensed professional personnel, and support personnel, and determine their salaries. I am requesting board approval for the personnel issues listed below. I recommend the Board . . .

- Accept the resignation and retirement of Bobbi McVey as a paraeducator in Jacobson Elementary.
- Accept the resignation of Joe Perez as custodian.
- Accept the resignation of Yvonne Sanchez as Head Baker and cook.
- Accept the resignation of Kristiana Reinsmoen as kindergarten classroom teacher.
- Accept the resignation of Lyndi Skrovig as co-head volleyball coach.
- Appoint Wendy Meints as Varsity Assistant Girls Track Coach with terms of employment according to the master agreement.
- Appoint Trinity Shirk as an elementary teacher assigned to the lower elementary grades (to be determined). Ms. Shirk will graduate this spring with a Bachelor of Science degree in elementary education from Iowa State University with a 3.95 GPA and endorsements in both reading and mathematics. She has good references. I recommend she be placed at entry level in the BA Lane (\$44,000) according to the master agreement.
- Appoint Bailee Frayne as an elementary teacher assigned to the lower elementary grades (to be determined). Ms. Frayne graduated in December with a Bachelor of Science degree in elementary education from William Penn University in Oskaloosa, Iowa, where she was a four-year letter winner on the Quaker golf team. She has been doing a long-term substitute job for us this winter. I recommend she be placed at entry level in the BA Lane (\$44,000) according to the master agreement.

- Accept the resignation of Judy Aldridge as secretary at the high school.
- Appoint Nikki McMurray as Basketball Cheer Sponsor for the season just completed.
