Required from homeschooling students to participate in the Ferris ISD Arts & Athletic Program:

Before practice participation:

- 1. Current Physical and Paperwork approved by Doctor & Ferris Athletic Training Staff
- Planet HS Paperwork completed by student and parents/guardians including Student & Athletic Handbook, UIL Acknowledgement of rules, code of conduct, and expectations.
- 3. Vaccination Record submitted to School Nurse & Ferris Athletic Training Staff
- 4. Basic Skills Test VARSITY ONLY
 - Standardized test verifying grade level **IF** participating during the **first six-weeks** of the school year.

"As a condition of eligibility to participate in a league activity during the first six weeks of a school year, a non-enrolled student must demonstrate grade-level academic proficiency on any nationally recognized, norm-referenced assessment instrument, such as the Iowa Test of Basic Skills, Stanford Achievement Test, California Achievement Test, or Comprehensive Test of Basic Skills.'

Before game participation:

- 1. Birth Certificate copies to Guidance Counselor, Nurse, Athletic Trainer, & Athletic Office
- 2. Class Schedule for courses enrolled in during the year to Guidance Counselor, Nurse, Athletic Trainer & Athletic Office
- 3. Name of Curriculum and copies if possible (digital preferable)
- Documentation of credits
- 5. Physical Address Verification must live within Ferris ISD to participate. Include Picture of Home from outside and bedroom of student-athlete.
- 6. Other documentation community service, letters of recommendation
- 7. Six Weeks Grade Checks and Semester Grades need to be sent to the same emails on or before due dates
