




88th Legislative Session Update - Property Tax Bills

- o HB 1
 - \$17.3B Property tax reduction Tier 1 tax rate compression
 - \$2.4B Increase to Tier 2 penny yield
 - DISD receives no benefit in FY24 due to Formula Transition Grant
 - \$5B for other school funding increases
- o HB 2
 - Reduce maximum compressed tax rate by \$0.15 in 2023-2024
 - Tax Year 2024 Appraisal cap of 10% lowered to 5% and apply to all real property




- o SB 3 Increase Homestead Exemption to \$70,000
- o SB 4
 - Would allow the floor of the Tier 1 tax rate to be 20% lower than the highest Tier 1 tax rate.
 - Reduce highest Tier 1 rate by an amount determined through the appropriations process.
 - Additional \$0.07?
