**AGENDA ITEM:** Consider Approval of the “Statement of Impact” Related to the New Horizon International Leadership Institute.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- In accordance with TEA guidelines, proposed charter schools must submit a “Statement of Impact” to any public school district that may be affected by this new, proposed campus.
- These statements must be considered by Trustees in an open board meeting and must be returned to TEA by a stated deadline.
- The New Horizon International Leadership Institute, a proposed K-12 charter school who application address originates at 1401 Meadowland Terrance (sic), has made application of the Texas Education Agency to license a charter campus. The administrative offices of the proposed charter school are located at the same address.
- This school, if approved by TEA, will draw enrollment from several area districts across the DFW area. As can be seen the physical address of the school is generally described as, “Within Dallas Fort Worth Metroplex and other surrounding areas within Tarrant, Denton, Dallas, Parker, Johnson, Collin, Rockwall and Ellis counties.”
- The physical location of the campus is 27 miles from the AISD Administration Building as is estimated as a 33 minute drive across Fort Worth to a location approximately one mile east of East Loop 820.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION.:**

- Approval of this impact statement as “no impact” should have no appreciable negative effect on the finances of the district because of its location.

**FISCAL NOTE:** Consideration of this impact statement will have no known adverse effect to the 2014-2015 budget.

**Administrative Recommendation:** Administration recommends approval of the charter school impact statement as having no impact to AISD.
