Parental Consent for Mental Health-Related Service

The 89th Texas Legislature recently passed Senate Bill 12, which requires school districts to notify parents of staff services related to mental health and to give parents/guardians the opportunity to opt out before mental health-related conditions are presided to this child.

In schools, counselors may give mental health-related services as defined by statute. These services fall under the responsibilities outlined in the Texas Education Code. The following are services required by law, only a portion of which are at the discretion of parents.


