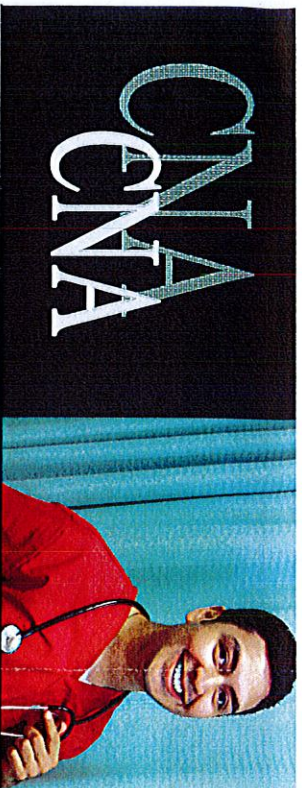

PURPOSE

The nurse aide course is preparation for entry level nurse aides to achieve a level of knowledge, skills and abilities essential to provide basic care to residents of long-term care facilities. Topics consist of basic nursing skills, residents' rights, communication, safety, observation, reporting and assisting residents in maintaining basic comfort and safety. Emphasis on effective interaction with members of the health care team. Incorporates the Department of Aging and Disability Services approved curriculum. Includes First Aid/CPR certification.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. TABE Test (recent Accuplacer or THEA scores accepted)
2. Current TB Test
3. Hepatitis B Series (must have all three shots by registration)
4. Criminal background check (to be completed by SWTJC) Valid Drivers License/ID and Social Security Card

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

NURA 1001 Nurse Aide for Health Care (59 hours)

Preparation for entry level nursing assistants to achieve a level of knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to provide basic care to residents of long-term care facilities. Topics include resident's rights, communication, safety, observation, reporting and assisting residents in maintaining basic comfort and safety. Emphasis on effective interaction with members of the health care team. Provide basic care to residents in a long-term care facility; communicate and interact effectively with residents and their families based on sensitivity to the psychosocial needs; and assist residents in attaining and maintaining basic comfort and safety. Protect, support, and promote the rights of the residents; provide safety and preventive measures in the care of residents; demonstrate skills in observing and reporting; and function effectively as a member of the health care team.

EMSP 1019 CPR for Healthcare Providers (8 hours)

Designed for healthcare providers and professional rescuers. Lifesaving skills of respiratory (choking and near-drowning) and cardiac emergencies involving adults, children, and infants. Students will show proficiency according to current guidelines of the credentialing agency.

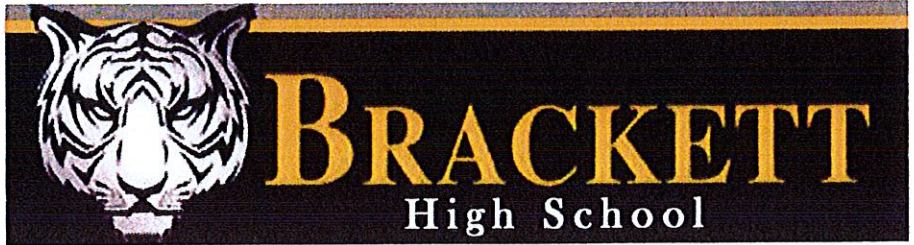
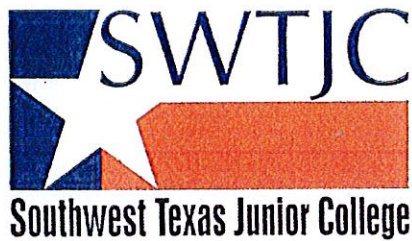
Course Descriptions (continued)

NURA 1060 Clinical-Nurse/Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant (48 hours)

A health-related work-based learning experience that enables the student to apply specialized occupational theory, skills, and concepts. Direct supervision is provided by the clinical professional. As outlined in the learning plan, apply the theory, concepts, and skills involving specialized materials, tools, equipment, procedures, regulations, laws, and interactions within and among political, economic, environmental, social, and legal systems associated with the occupation and the business/industry and will demonstrate legal and ethical behavior, safety practices, interpersonal and teamwork skills, and appropriate written and verbal communication skills using the terminology of the occupation and the business/industry.

Credit for Professional Certification

A student already certified as a CNA may apply for advanced placement credit for the basic skills course. A student who is a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) may receive credit for: VNSG 1323 Basic Nursing Skills (3 hours)



Requirements to Register:

- *Photo copy of:* (Legal names must match ID cards)
- Valid Driver's License or ID
- Social Security Card
- TB skin test results
- Hepatitis B Series (must have all 3 shots by time of registration)
- Criminal History Check (conducted by SWTJC)

This course will train students in the essential skills needed to provide basic care to patients.

Students who successfully complete the program will be prepared for an entry-level position as a nursing assistant.
