Services and Medication Issues that are not listed on IEPs (Individual Education Plan) -routine for all students

- Utilize the nursing process and adhere to the NASN -School Nurse Scope and Standards of Practice
- 2. Document the effectiveness of nursing interventions
- 3. Educate school personnel in basic emergency procedures
- 4. Notify parents, guardian of any physical or emotional changes
- 5. Immunization Compliance
- 6. Provide first aid and assessment of illness
- 7. Participate on the education planning teams both multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary that address health, safety, ethical risks, benefits and outcomes
- 8. Provide routine health screenings as mandated by the state- and screenings as needed for ARDs
- 9. Serve as a liaison who communicates with physicians and other health care providers
- 10. Maintain documentation of school health and immunization records
- 11. Report to parents, administrators or heal care providers any concerns regarding a student
- 12. Update and train staff to meet needs of students
- 13. Advocate for all students to prevent unnecessary restrictions
- 14. Maintain and interpret health data that addresses the student's needs and progress
- 15. Make and assist with referrals to outside agencies when indicated
- 16. Assist student with realistic goal setting
- 17. Active and support listening
- 18. Encourage and support student decision making when possible
- 19. Serve as first responder to any medical emergency
- 20. Assist administration with evaluation for untoward behavior
- 21. Personal hygiene instruction classroom/or individual
- 22. Health education for personal physical and mental, dental care, nutrition, healthy decision making
