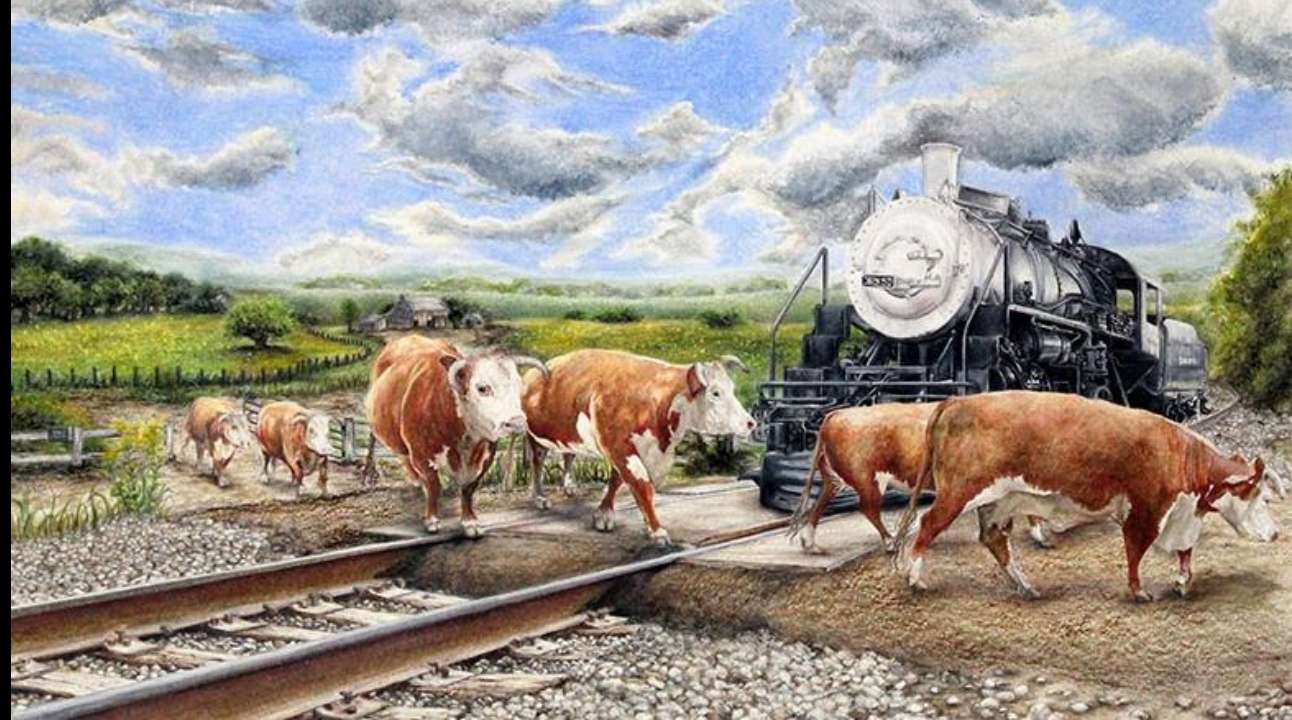

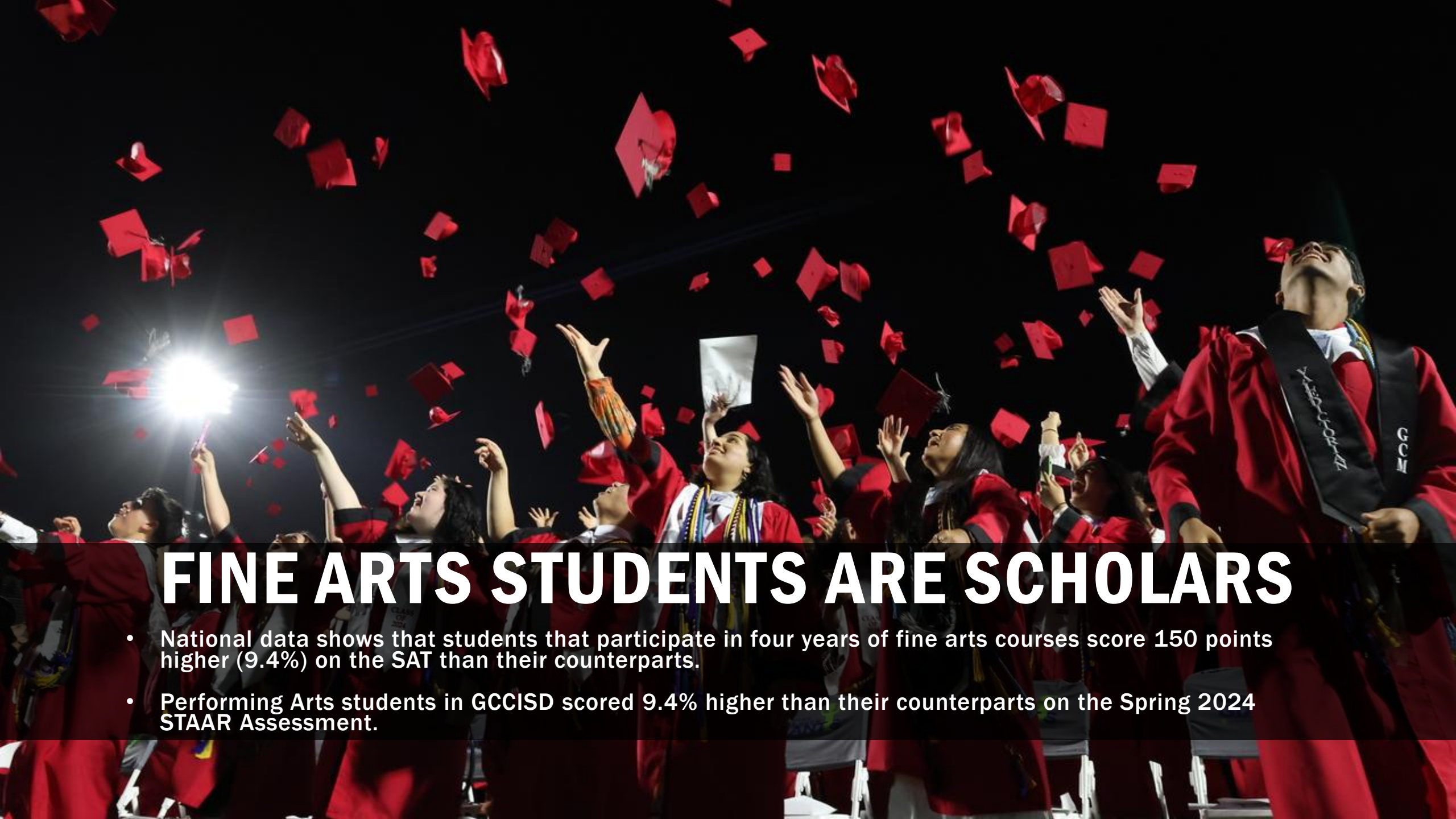

FINE ARTS STUDENTS ARE SCHOLARS

- National data shows that students that participate in four years of fine arts courses score 150 points higher (9.4%) on the SAT than their counterparts.
- Performing Arts students in GCCISD scored 9.4% higher than their counterparts on the Spring 2024 STAAR Assessment.

FINE ARTS LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

- The state legislature has introduced HB 172/SB 549 which introduce the need for dedicated Fine Arts funding to the public education finance system.
- HB 172 has been filed as of 11/12/2024
- SB 549 has been referred to the Education committee as of 2/3/25
