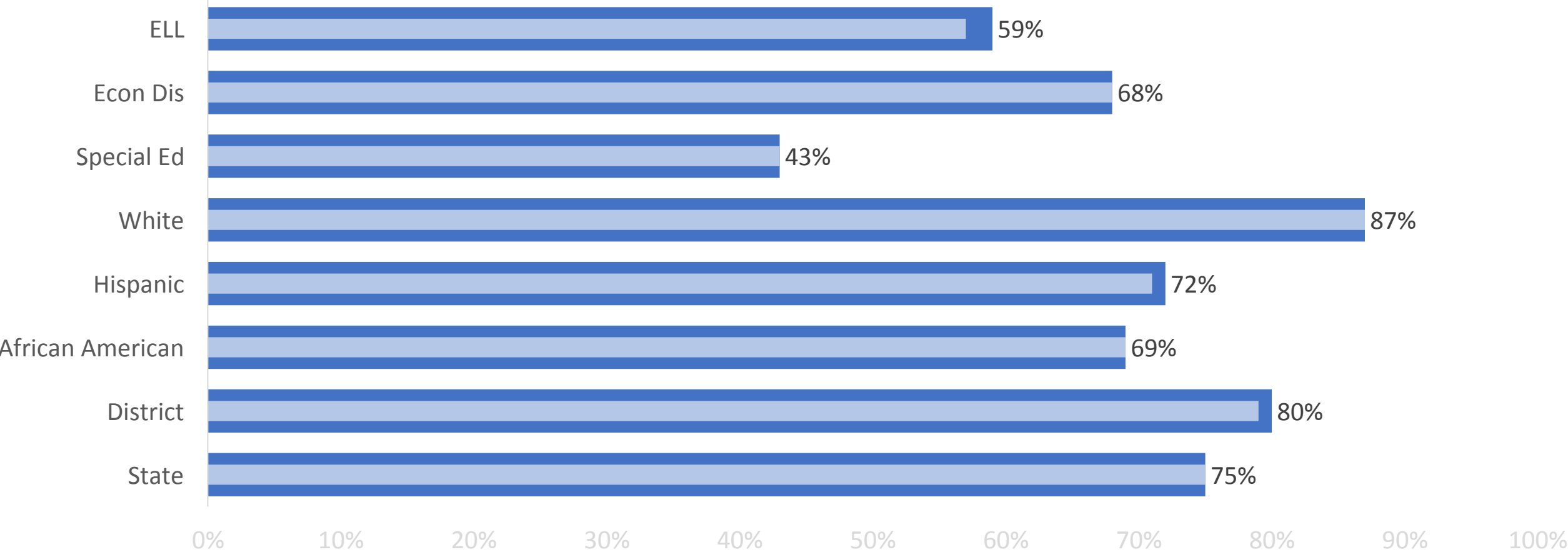

STAAR Percent at Approaches Standard or Above, All Grades, All Subjects

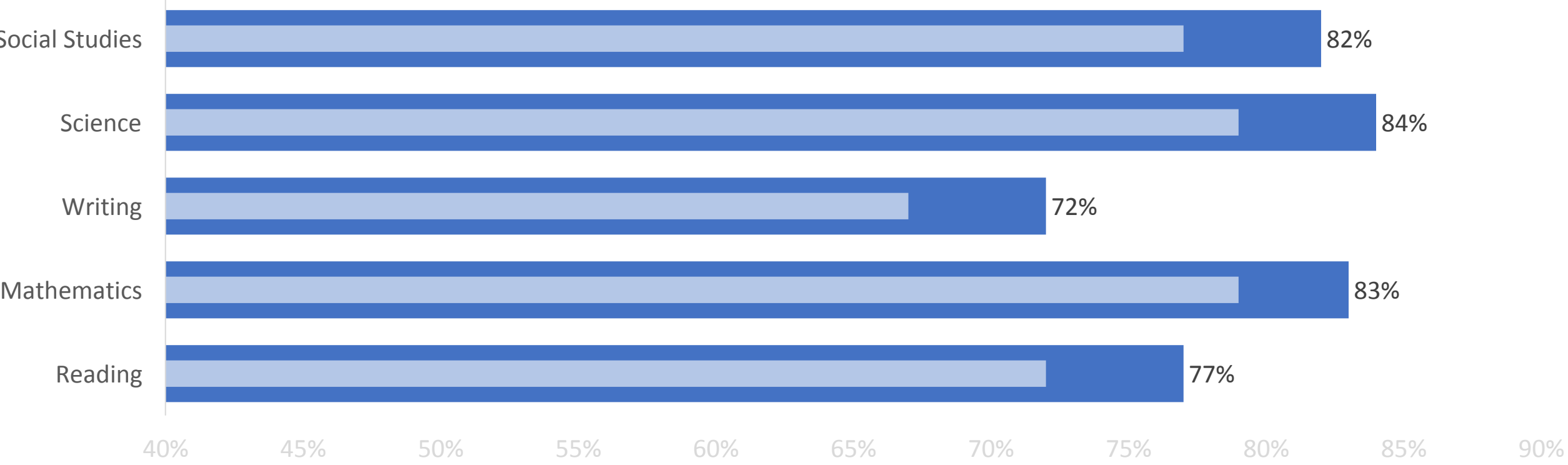

Denton ISD scored above the State average in all subject areas

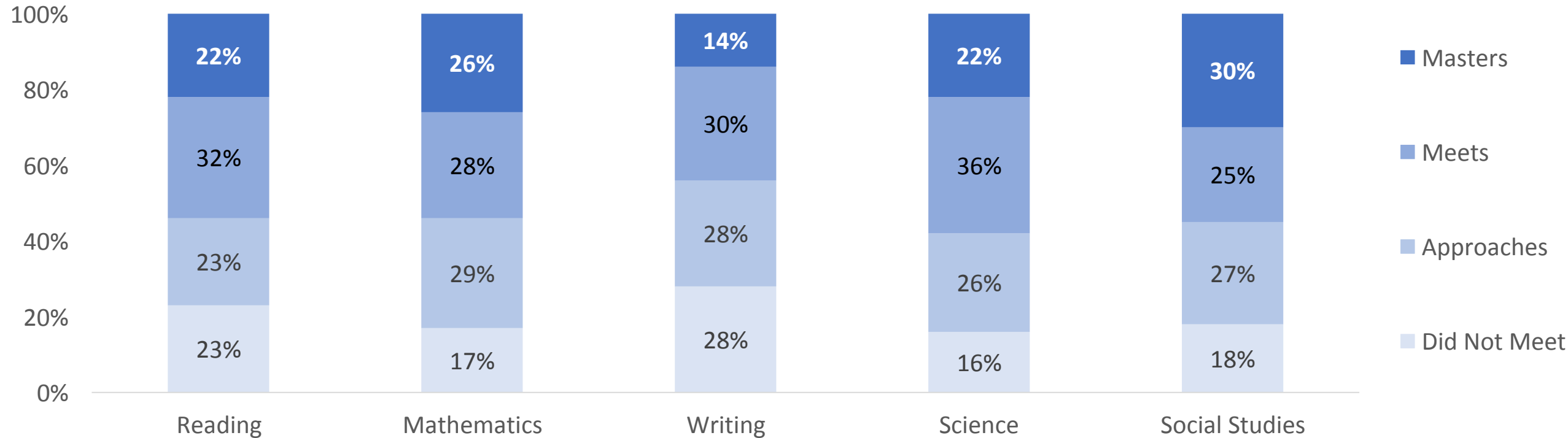
STAAR Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above, All Grades

STAAR Percent at Each Passing Standard, All Grades



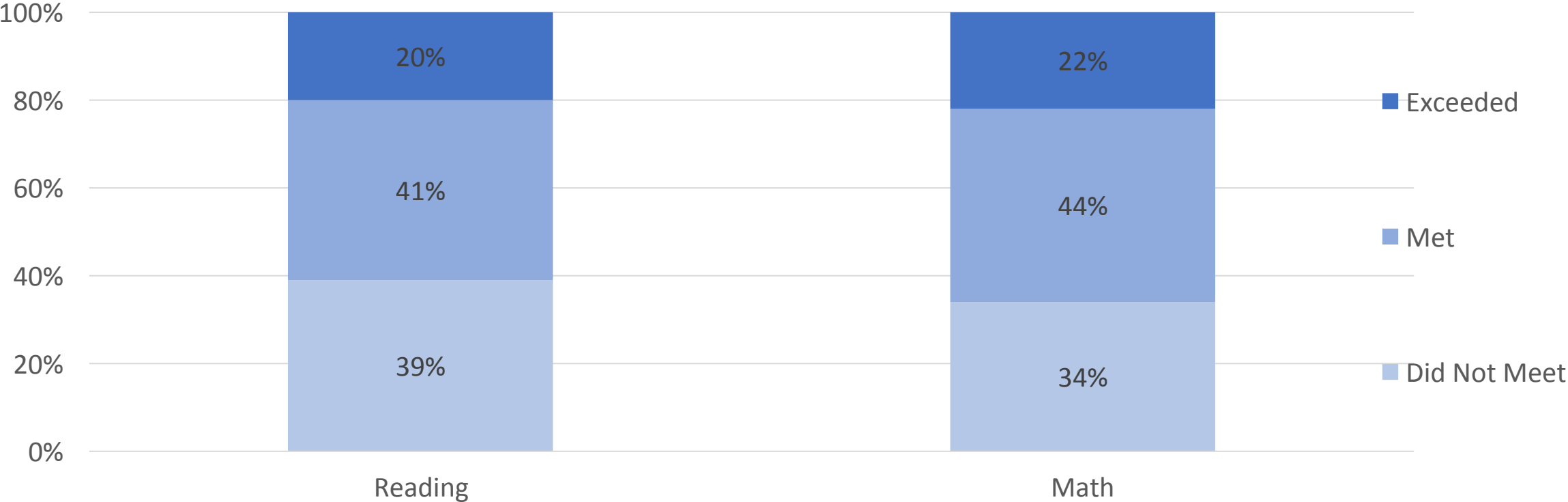
99% of our students were tested, which is the state norm.

The participation rate must be at least **95%**.

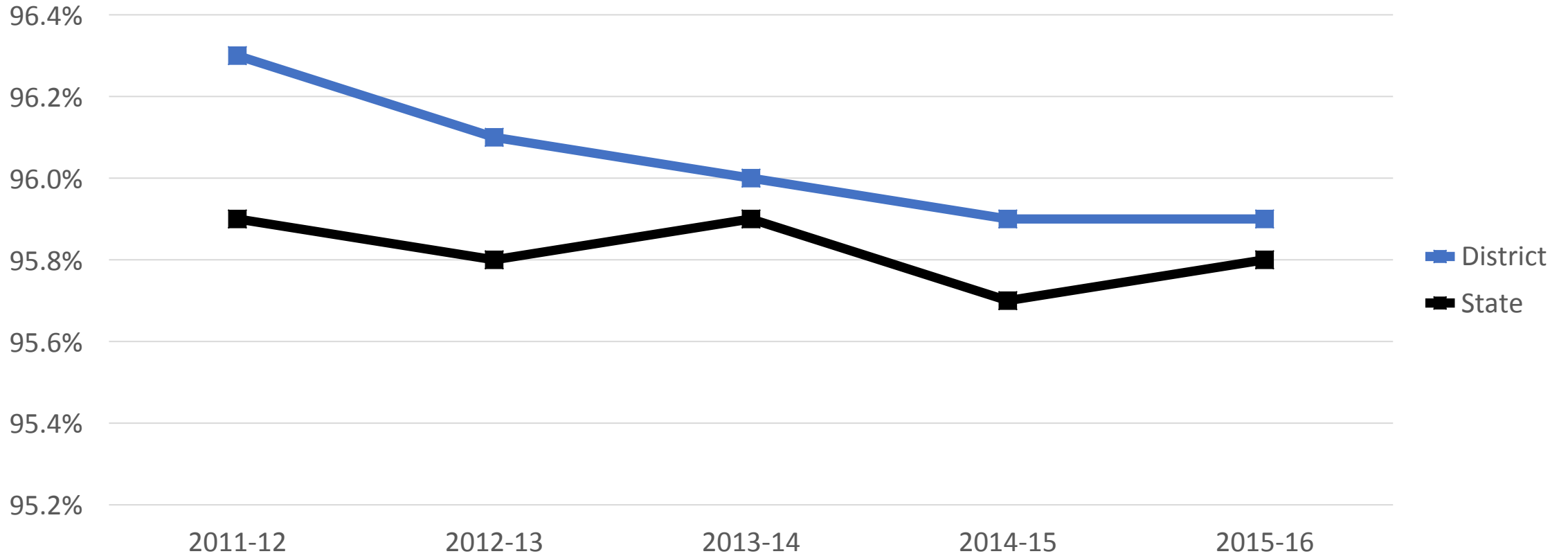
63% of the students Met or Exceeded Progress on the STAAR assessments for Reading and Mathematics

District attendance has been declining at a higher rate than the State

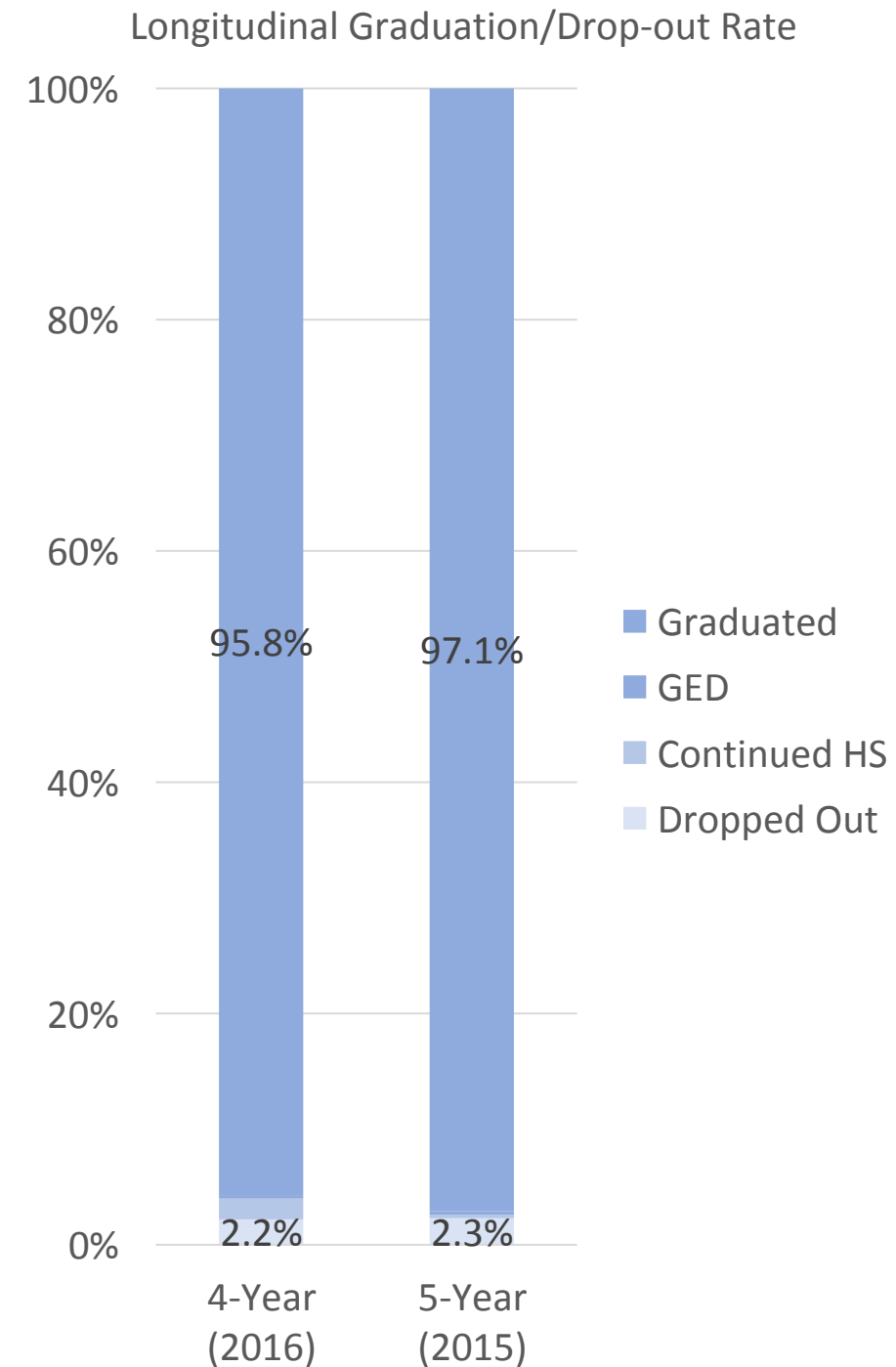
Attendance Rate

DISD longitudinal graduation is the cohort of 9th graders expected to graduate in 4 years.

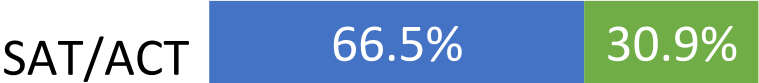
Of the 2016 graduates, **92.2%** received the **Recommended High School Program** or **Distinguished Achievement Program** diploma.

The average **SAT** score for the District, **1461** (86 points higher than the State average).

The average **ACT** score for the District, **21.6** (1.3 points higher than the State average).

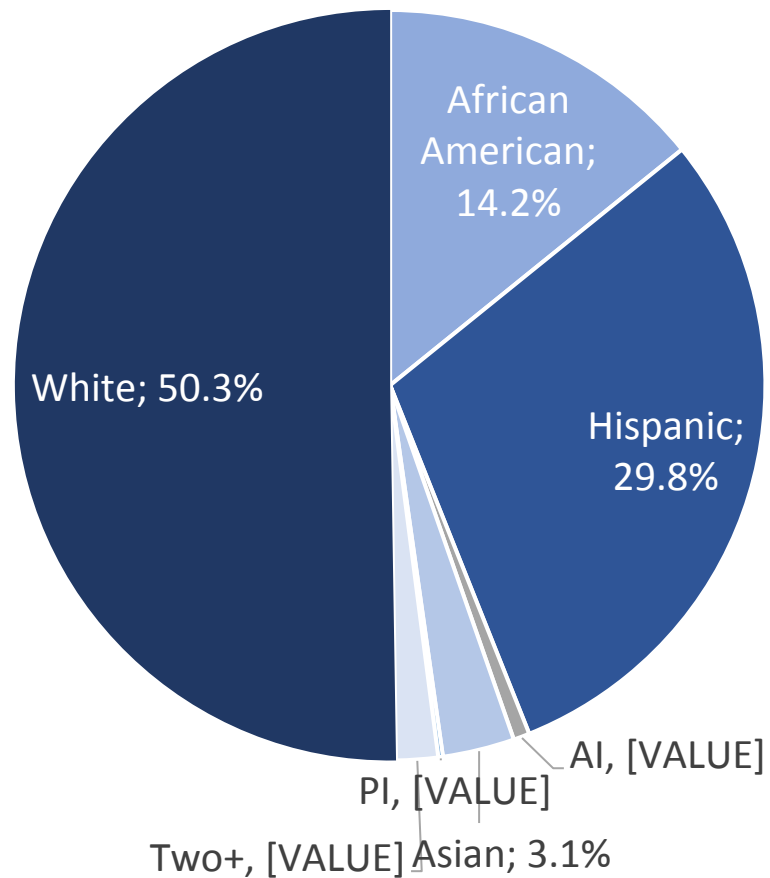

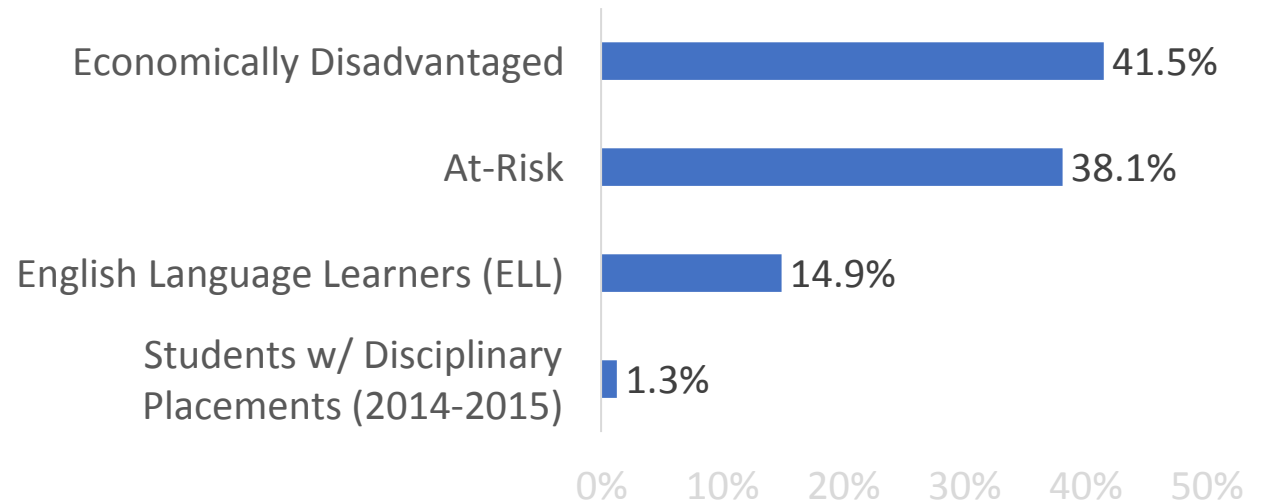
Although the **participation** rate for **AP/IB** dropped by 1.5% from the previous year, the percent scoring **at or above criterion** increased by **4.6%**.

DISD had **28,382** students in the 2016-17 school year

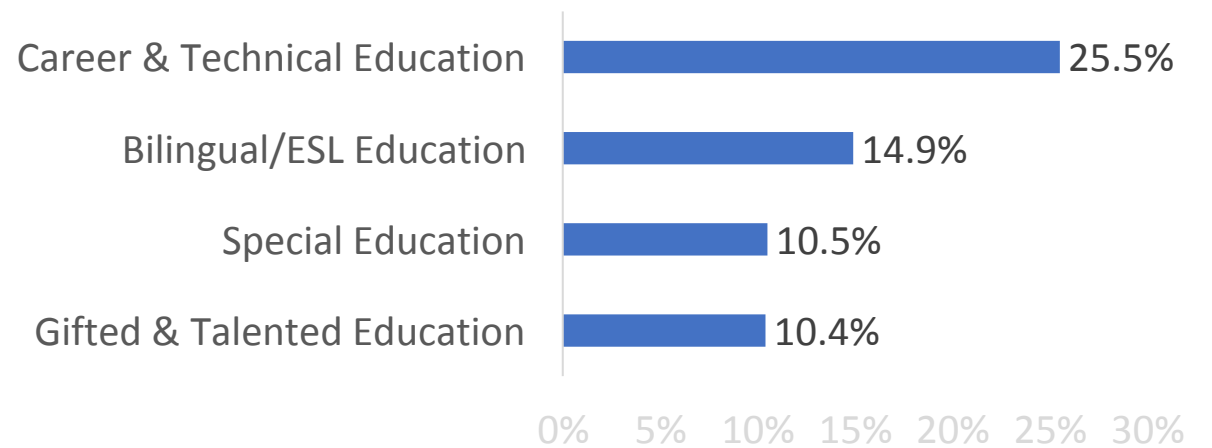
Student Ethnic Distribution



Student Demographics

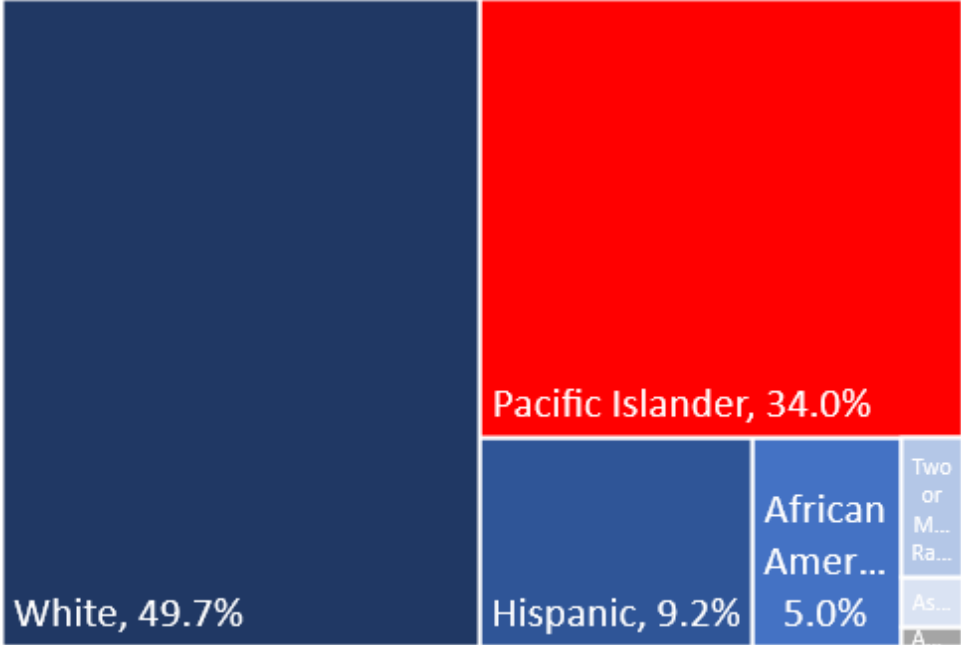


Student Enrollment by Program

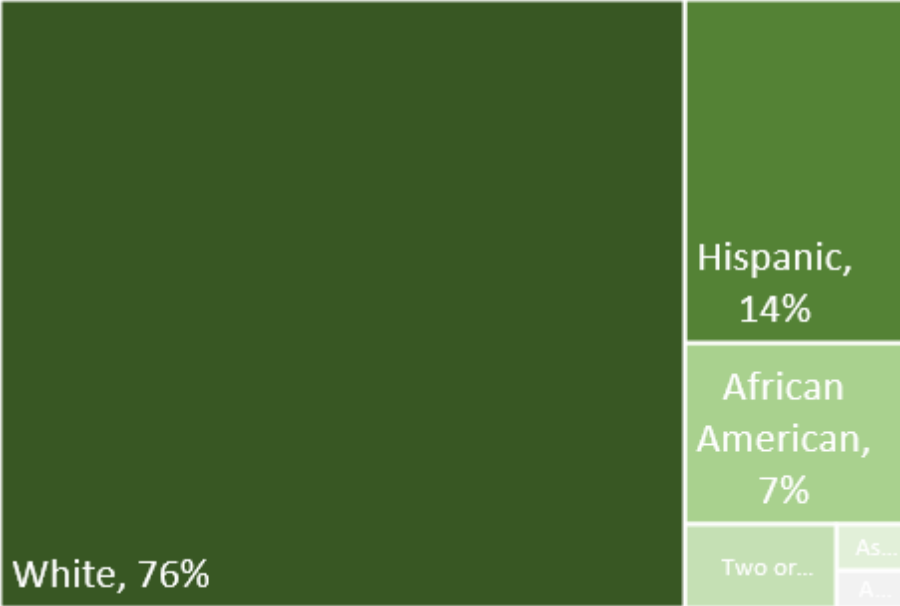


The TAPR **incorrectly** reflects there was a drastic increase in the percent of Pacific Islander teachers

Teachers by Ethnicity

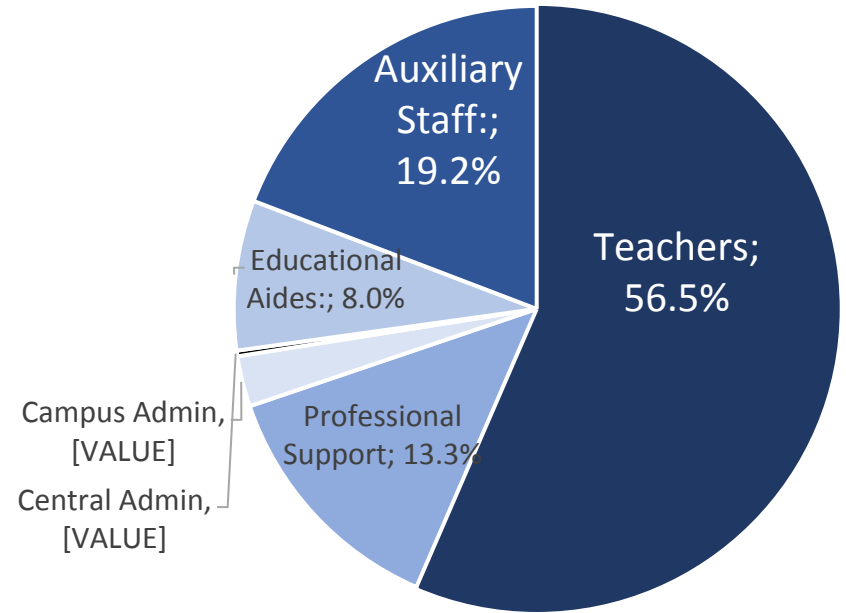


Teachers by Ethnicity (2016-17 Fall Collection, Resubmission)

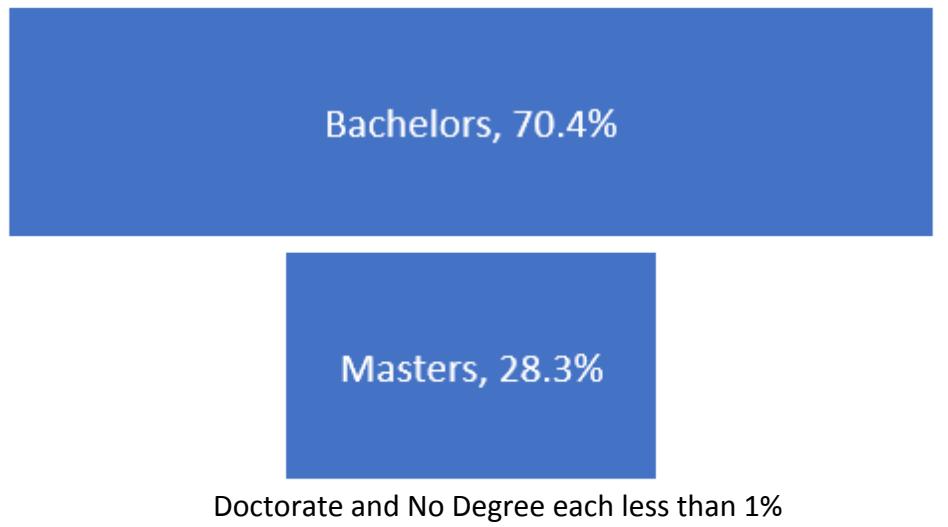


DISD had **3657** staff members in the 2016-17 school year
