In preparation for the WIBC audition these students have put in countless hours of practicing and several hours of supervised recording each. This process alone has increased their skills as a musician and increased the skill of the HVHS band as a whole. The tentative plans for this trip are as follows: Depart from HVHS early on the morning of Friday, November 21st. We will arrive late that evening at the Double Tree motel and check in.
