Who votes at the election? One representative from each of the local, public school boards in Hillsdale County.

There are three seats for election in 2019:

- ✓ *Term A: Seat 1 – This seat is a partial term for 4 years*
- ✓ *Term B: Seat 1 – This seat is a full term for 6 years*
- ✓ *Term B: Seat 2 – This seat is a full term for 6 years*



What to do if you're interested in being a board member of the HCISD...

1. Make your interest known by picking up a petition or paying \$100 to the Hillsdale County Clerk's Office.
2. Speak with Marney Kast, County Clerk, about properly completing the requirements.
3. You must select a specific seat for which you are running.
4. Turn in all paperwork to the County Clerk's Office by Monday, May 6, 2019 by 4:00 PM.
5. Attend the election on Monday, June 3, 2019 at 5:30 PM.

The order in which seats are elected will be primarily determined by the length of the term, and secondarily by the numerical order of a particular seat. This is the order in which seats will be filled at the 2019 election:

- 1) Term B: Seat 1 (6 years)
- 2) Term B: Seat 2 (6 years)
- 3) Term A: Seat 1 (4 years)

You need to know. State law allows for a maximum of two board members from the same district to serve at any given time. Once a school district's number of seats is fulfilled, any other candidate(s) from the same district will be disqualified from taking a board seat.
