Agenda Item Title: Consider the approval of bus donation from Avance-San Antonio to our Head Start program.

Description: On December 4, 2025, South San Antonio Independent School District was contacted by AVANCE-San Antonio regarding the potential donation of school buses. The primary requirement of this donation is that the buses must be assigned to a Head Start program that is a direct grant recipient, a condition that SSAISD meets.

In accordance with South San Antonio ISD Board Policy **CDC (Legal)**, acceptance of any donation with a value exceeding \$25,000 requires Board approval. Based on the provided appraisals, the combined value of the buses under consideration may exceed this threshold.

Attached for review are the appraisal documents for the buses being considered. Final determination of the specific buses and quantity to be allocated to SSAISD has not yet been confirmed. AVANCE has seven (7) buses they would like to donate. Northside ISD is also expected to receive a portion of the donated buses as part of this distribution. If approved, SSAISD will be responsible for the title transfer and associated taxes, estimated at \$22.50 per bus. AVANCE-San Antonio is currently seeking final approval from the Head Start program and its home office prior to confirming the final distribution of the buses. SSAISD will use the buses to transport Head Start students.

Approval at this time will allow SSAISD to proceed once AVANCE-San Antonio completes its internal authorization process.



Valuation Approach

Forced Liquidation Value (FLV) - the expected value with limited advertising, and the seller being compelled to sell with a sense of immediacy or involuntary on an as-is, where-is basis, often within 30 days.

Definitions

These terms are defined as follows:
