

DECLINING ENROLLMENT

- From 2018-current

- 73 student decline
- \$533,922

We believe the decline in enrollment is due to the fact that we have had to cut so many positions and programs. In order to keep all 3 campuses staffed for required positions, we have had to cut electives and extras.
