Since we aren't doing field trips this year many of our classrooms will be walking to some of the area parks to celebrate the end of the year. One grade level at a time at the parks so we don't have multiple grade levels playing together at the park at the same time.

Summer School 2021 Update–Summer School will take place June 14-25th. Summer school is a remedial program this year and is based on teacher recommendation in the areas of ELA and Math. Teachers recommended 117 students K-5 for summer school. Our current numbers show 56 students signed up for summer school so far this year. We are attempting to keep our student to teacher ratio at a number that provides as much small group instruction as possible to give the students recommended by their teachers the most beneficial academic boost in ELA and Math.

The break down by grade level is below.

Kindergarten – 8 students total – 8 students for Reading, 6 for Math

1st Grade – 13 students total – 12 students for Reading, 11 for Math

2nd Grade – 7 students total – 3 students for Reading, 4 for Math

3rd Grade – 11 students total – 10 students for Reading, 8 for Math

4th Grade – 10 students total – 9 students for Reading, 8 for Math

5th Grade – 7 students total – 7 students for Reading, 6 for Math
