5. Perceptual, motor, and physical development



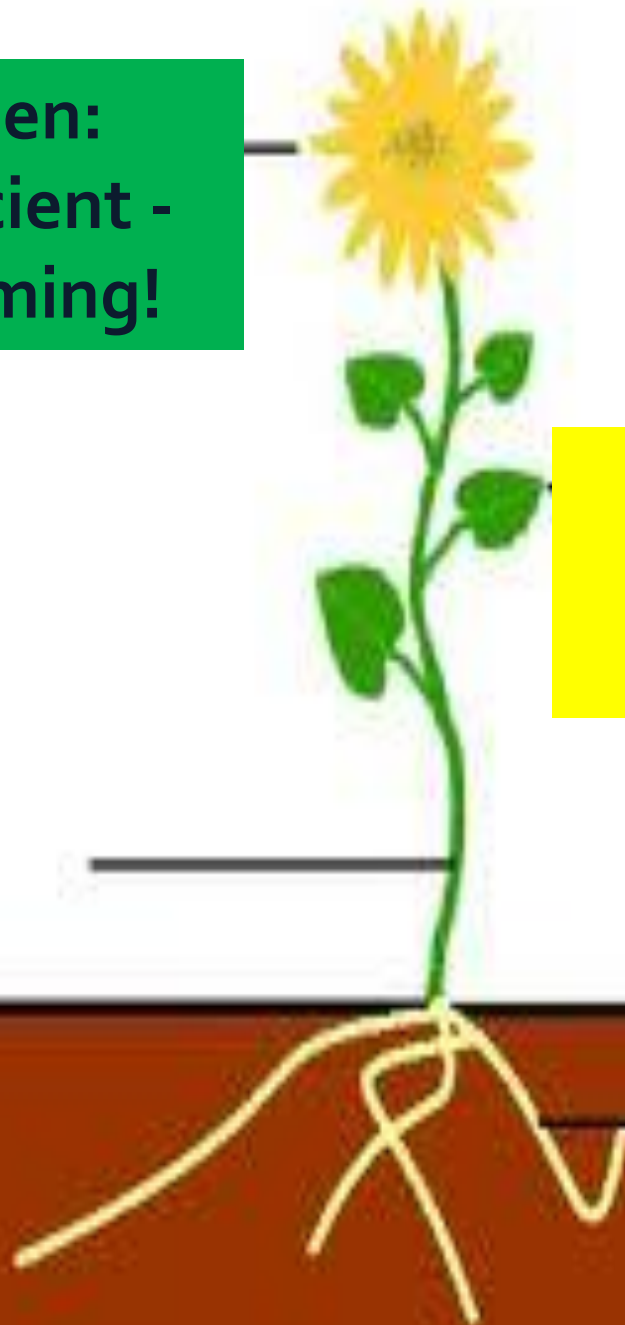

% of 4-yr olds enrolled full yr.

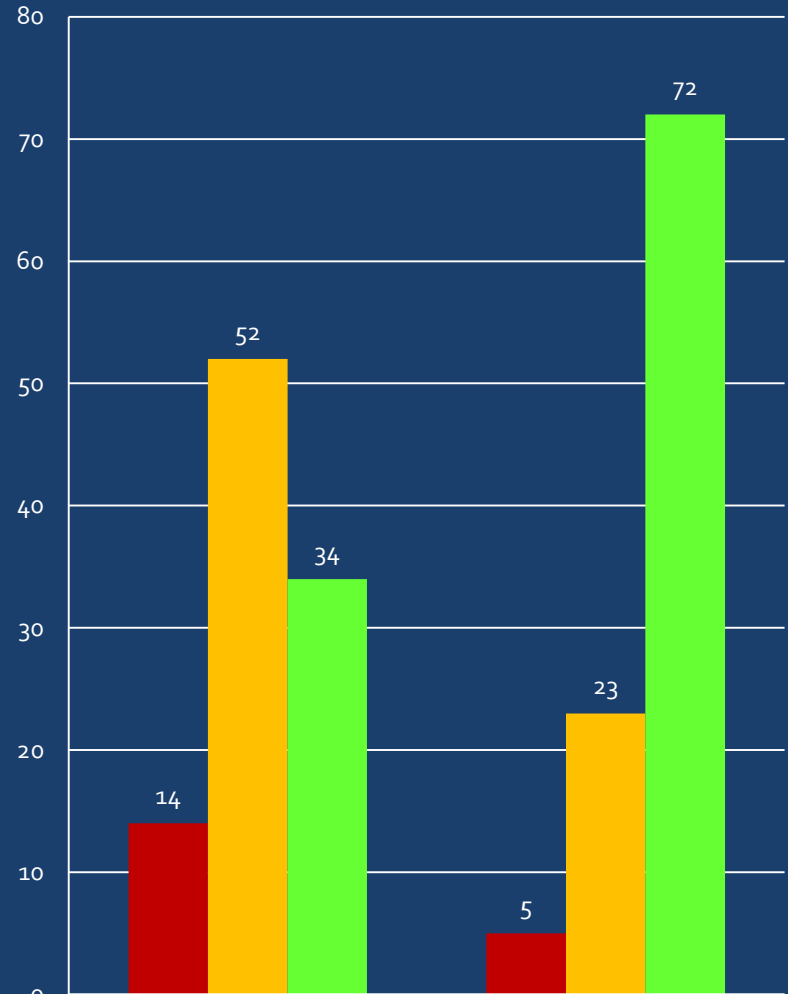
