Schedule

The local Carmel Building Permit was obtained on Friday, April 19, 2019 and the onsite demolition began on Monday, April 22, 2019. The project started +/- 2 weeks later than anticipated with the contract and permitting.

The preparation, review, approval and procurement of the structural steel (shop drawings) pushed the arrival and steel installation date to August 5th (from the original anticipated date of July 9th). Structural steel was installed in early August, followed closely by metal stud framing and exterior wall sheathing. The mechanical, electrical and plumbing "rough-in" is complete. The expanded area & existing building new roof 90% complete and drywall started the 1st week of October. Exterior concrete and site work is underway on the north side of the building.

Stentz Construction updated the current construction schedule with overlapping subcontractor work sequence as much as possible given the limited area of space. The current project schedule maintains the original mid-November substantial completion date.

Open Items

The GRFC cornice pieces will arrive after substantial completion. The exact arrival date has not yet ben determined. The areas of the missing cornice will be temporally capped / flashed so no weather will infiltrate the building envelope. Expected arrival of the GFRC pieces is Mid – December.
