Update on Reorganization, Building Additions, and Summer Renovation Projects

<u>Reorganization</u> – Item currently under consideration

Determine what needs to be moved and what can stay at each building

Determine new furniture needs and quote/bid furniture

Retain services of moving company to perform work to move materials and furniture between schools

Retain services of three to four individuals to assist with the coordination of the moving companies.

Possibly rent storage containers to hold furniture if necessary while renovations are underway.

Determine which playground equipment is appropriate for each site as we reorganize and move equipment as necessary

<u>Building Additions</u> – Projects currently under contract

Joyner Elementary – Roof decking and felt are 100%, block and exterior insulation are 100%, Contractor anticipates completion in April

Parkway Elementary – The roof is 95% complete, painting is 70% complete, HVAC is 70% complete, Plumbing is 85% complete, contractor anticipates completion beginning of March

Pierce Street Elementary – Contractor has asked for substantial completion walk through for the interior of the building. Contractor is continuing to work on the site work including storm drainage, fine grading, sidewalks.

Rankin Elementary – Construction is complete

Thomas Street Elementary – Substantial completion walk through has been completed and contractor has requested final walk through the week of January 26th.

Renovation Projects for Summer 2009 – Projects currently under consideration

Portico Addition at the Lawhon Elementary Administration Building (B Building) Renovation of bathrooms at the Lawhon Elementary current Kindergarten/1st grade Building (A Building)

Renovation of the Carver Elementary main office and main entrance Window Replacement at Church Street Elementary

Replacement of Miscellaneous Exterior Doors at Tupelo High School Installation of A/C at Lawhon Elementary Gym and Milam Gym

Replace Carpet with VCT at Tupelo High School B Bldg 1st floor classrooms Renovation projects submitted from principals on their building level strategic five year plan. These are due to Central Office at the end of January.
